Knobel will target youth for GOP

Nebraska youth will be one of the Republican Party's main targets in the coming state election, according to the party's state chairman.

"Don't forget the young people. It's easy to attract them and they want to vote," Ralph Knobel told those attending a Lancaster County Republican convention last Friday.

Knobel said the party has a head start in Nebraska because of its Republican governor and administration. He emphasized the importance of voter registration both in rural areas and in large cities like Lincoln.

Knobel called for a commitment to elect Republicans and correct 40 years of what he called Democratic Party taxes, regulations that restrict freedoms and "Democratic redistribution of wealth, taking from those who work and giving to those who don't.

"Profit is not a dirty word and poverty is not a virtue," he said.

He said the Republican party supports the creation of more wealth and use of more capital.


Daily Nebraskan gets East Campus office
