The ease with which the Husker defense stopped the highly-touted Colorado offense was a key factor in the game. "We were well prepared," nose guard Jeff Merrell said. "Going into the game we thought they had a pretty good offensive team. It was sure nice to get the shutout."

"I'm really impressed with us on defense," Osborne said. "They played extremely well."

The Huskers now point toward the rest of the Big Eight season. Several players said this game gives them the confidence they need to win the rest of the conference games.

"We wanted to get off to a good start and we did that," right tackle Dan Hurley said. "The coaches had us well prepared."
