Gas fire burns storage building

A storage barn and its contents valued at \$60,000 went up in flames early Tuesday afternoon at 3150 S. 58th St., according to District 3 Fire Chief Robert King.

King said the fire started after two men were removing a gas tank from a Chevy Blazer truck and spilled gasoline. When the men tried to move the truck to clean up the gasoline, a trouble light was knocked off from the building, landing in the gasoline and sparking the fire, King said.

Four fire trucks were sent at 12:42 p.m. to put out the fire. David Hutchinson of Lincoln is the owner of the building.
