'Playboy' coming to uncover the beauties of UNL

A representative from *Playboy* magazine is coming to Lincoln to add some UNL beauties to its "Girls of the Big Eight" pictorial.

The pictorial is scheduled to appear in the September issue, along with the magazine's forecast for the next college football

According to David Salyers, Playboy's director of public relations, photographer David Chan is working his way toward Lincoln from other Big Eight schools.

"He did Norman (Okla.) last week and is to be in Stillwater this week," Salyers said. Chan keeps his own schedule, he said, so the actual date he arrives at UNL is tentative.

According to Salyers, Chan will set up in a hotel close to campus, purchase an ad in the college and possibly local papers, and wait for responses.

Playboy, which has done the same type of feature with several other conferences, usually gets a pretty good response from potential models, Salvers said.

The models must be UNL students and at least 18 years old.

\$100 to \$400, depending on how much clothing they take off, Salvers said. That amount is totally up to the model. Models photographed will be paid half the fee immediately and receive the other half if their photos are published.

"If you look at past issues you'll notice that we've published everything from fully nude to completely dressed," Salyers said.


Salyers went on to say there has been surprisingly little controversy about the pictorials in the past, and although they haven't heard from Chan, Playboy doesn't expect many problems with the "Girls of the Big Eight" feature.

Salvers said there were other advantages to the modeling offers besides the money. Some models have gone on to do centerfolds for the magazine, Salvers said.

The pictorials are not, however, meant especially to highlight the schools, he said.

"I don't think we play that up too much," Salyers said. We're saying, hey, there are some pretty good-looking girls out there and we're going to present them to you.

AFROTC detachment gets award

UNL's Air Force ROTC detachment No. 465 was awarded one of only 10 national meritorious service awards at a formal ceremony in the Nebraska Union Thursday, Feb. 24.

At the same ceremony, Master Sgt. Kenneth Jording retired, and was awarded a meritorious service medal after 20 years as the Non-Commissioned Officer in charge of the UNL detachment.

Lt. Col. Ned Criscimagna, assistant professor of aerospace studies, said the AFROTC award was given for the distinguished and professional contributions made by the members of the detachment during 1979 and 1980.

During that period the detachment increased its enrollment by 65 percent, more than doubled its number of cadets on scholarship, and consistently ranked in the top 10 detachments nationally, based on the quality of its cadets, Criscimagna said.

Col. John Oliphant, Midwest area comandant for the AFROTC, presented the award to the detachment commander, Col. James W. DuBois.

"We feel that this award belongs as much to the university as to the detachment," Criscimagna said. "This university, even through the throws of Vietnam, has had a healthy relationship with the ROTC."
