Model UN invites speakers

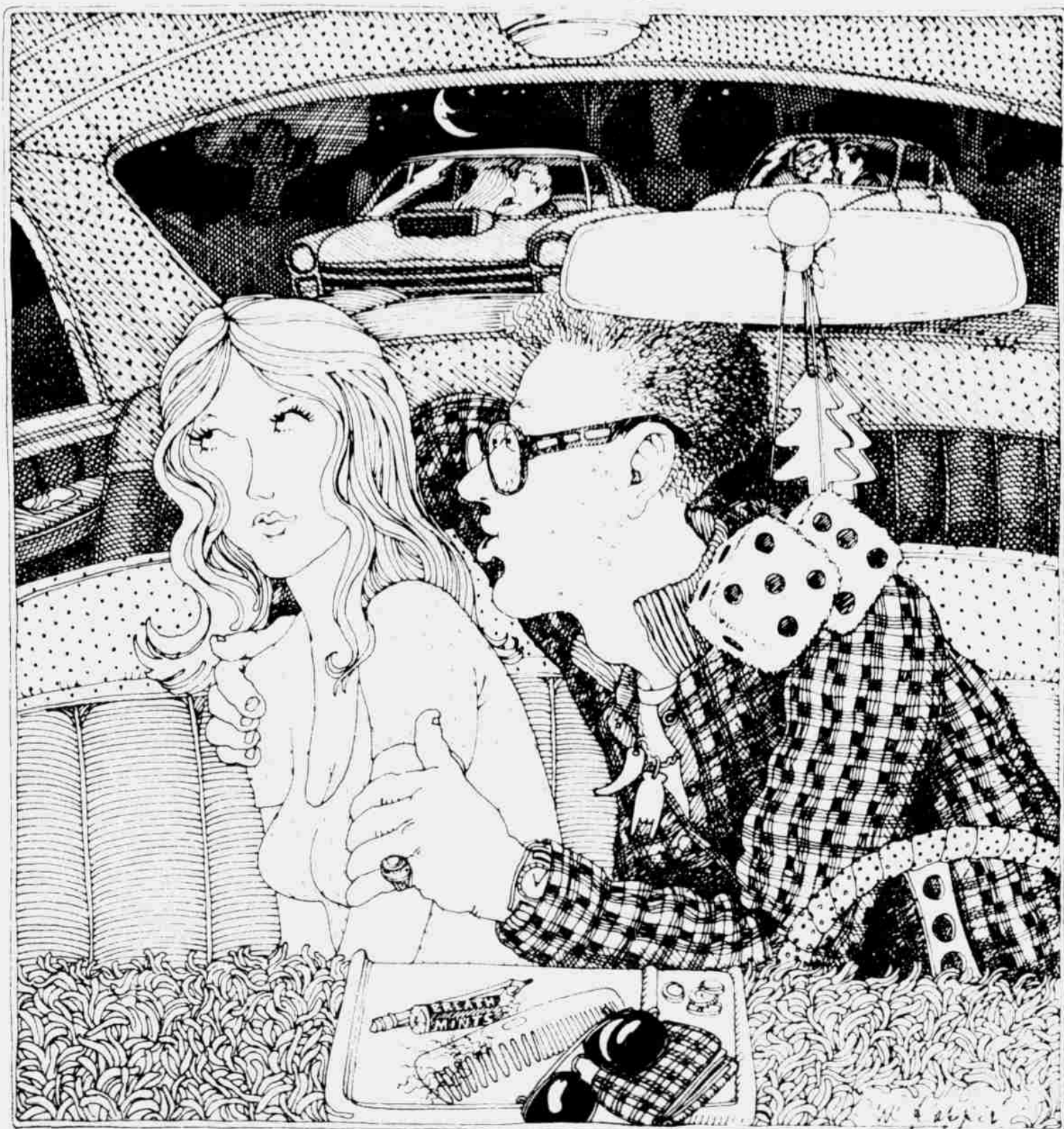
Donald McHenry, former U.S. ambassador to the United Nations, and Jean Gazarian, who has been with the United Nations since 1946, will be featured speakers during UNL Nebraska Model United Nations Week, March 3 through 6. Gazarian is the director of the Division of General Assembly Affairs for the United Nations in New York, according to Howard Dickerson, MUN secretary-general.

The UNL event will begin with McHenry's speech at 8 p.m. Wednesday in the Nebraska Union. Admission is \$3 for nonstudents and free with a student ID. General Assembly committees will meet all day

Thursday and Friday morning. Gazarian will speak March 5 at 10:30 a.m. in the union. Admission is free. The General Assembly will end March 6 at 6 p.m.

The NMUN International Court of Justice will hear its first case Thursday at 4 p.m. March 5 at 3:30 p.m. the court will hear the Iraq vs. Iran case, which involves the bombing of a nuclear reactor in Iraq. The court's final case, the United States vs. the Soviet Union, is March 6 at 9:30 a.m. It is about the use of biological weapons, said John Sunnygard, court president.

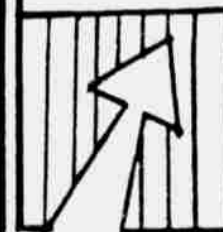

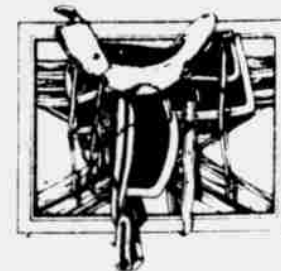
