

# Lauded St. Louis Orchestra to play

Appearing for its ninth time to a sell-out crowd is the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra directed by Leonard Slatkin. They will perform for one night only at the Kimball Recital Hall, 11th and R streets, at 8 p.m. Monday. Although the concert is sold out, the box office is taking a waiting list and urging those that have tickets they will not use to turn them in to the Kimball Box Office for possible resale.

In 1973, the St. Louis Symphony became one of 14 orchestras in the United States with a full 52-week season. In 1978, Leonard Slatkin became the first American music director in the St. Louis Symphony's 100-year history. Slatkin, who began his conducting career with the orchestra in 1968, is one of the few American-born and American-trained musicians to become music director of a major symphony orchestra.

In a recent *San Francisco Examiner* interview, Slatkin noted with pride the orchestra's performances "are now consistently on a high level." The article went on to state, "Critics generally agree the St. Louis Symphony is becoming one of the strongest orchestras in the country."

During this, its 102nd season, the St. Louis Symphony will play 54 orchestral series, four Chamber Orchestra, 15 "Pops at Powell" and 38 educational concerts in its home at Powell Symphony Hall. The orchestra also tours regionally and nationally including a yearly appearance at Carnegie Hall.

The program for their performance here in Lincoln is Schumann's "Symphony No. 4 in D minor," and Shostakovich's "Symphony No. 8 in C minor, Op. 65."
