NOW hasn't exactly retreated from this position, but its refusal to make a stronger show of support for lesbian concerns does little to bolster its credibility in the eyes of the more radical sector of the lesbian groups.

The delegates did, however, propose resolutions concerning education, communications and legislation regarding lesbian issues. A videotape series on alternate lifestyles and a national conference on lesbian issues are among its plans.

"I'll believe it when I see it," was the reaction of one woman I talked to, a lesbian and former member of NOW who wished to remain anonymous. "Resolutions are nice, but they're not the same as action. We're at the bottom of the pile as far as priorities are concerned."

But another woman, also a lesbian and former Lincoln NOW member, had a different view: "NOW has made more visible efforts in this area than any other group. Ten years ago we couldn't even talk about lesbian concerns. Now, at least we have some recognition."

Lesbians are still something of an embarrassment to the women's movement. Perhaps it is time for powerful groups like NOW to change that "stepsister" image. <section-header><section-header><text><text><text><text><text><text><text><text>
