In what could have been his finest hour, Thone chose to be consistently supportive of a failing financial policy while leaving to the Legislature and his successor the duty of facing financial reality.

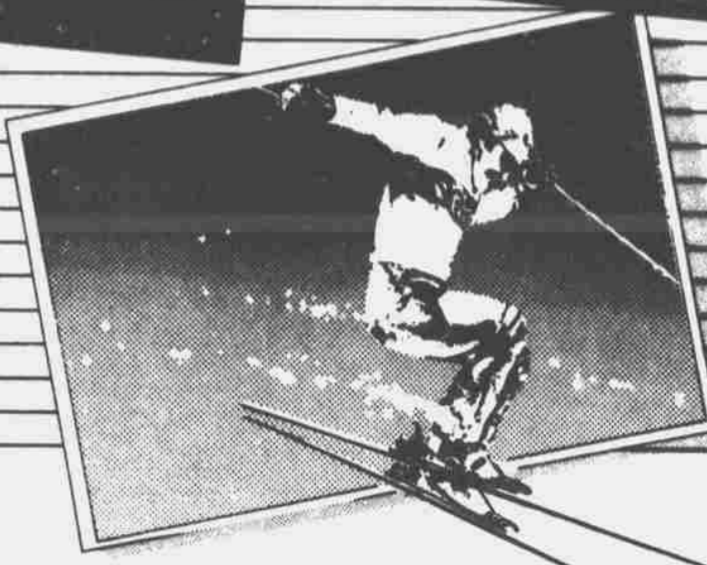

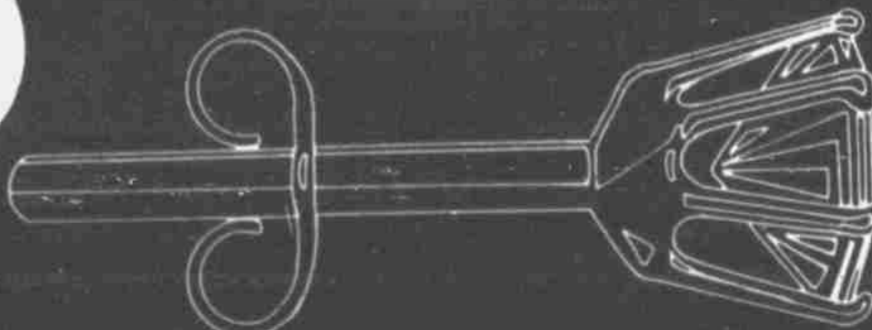
