

Massengale joins scholarship board

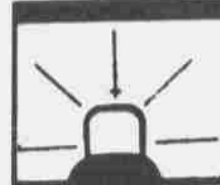
UNL Chancellor Martin Massengale was named to the National Merit Scholarship Corporation's Board of Directors Nov. 22.

Massengale will join business and educational leaders on the 20-member board chaired by John S. Reed, who is chairman of Santa Fe Industries. Members of the board serve a three-year term.

The scholarship corporation is a non-profit organiza-

tion that conducts the annual National Merit Scholarship Program. The program recognizes top high school students throughout the United States and awards scholarships financed by grants from over 600 corporations, company foundations, professional organizations, colleges and universities.

Over 18,000 Merit Scholarship winners are enrolled in undergraduate study at about 675 U.S. colleges and universities.

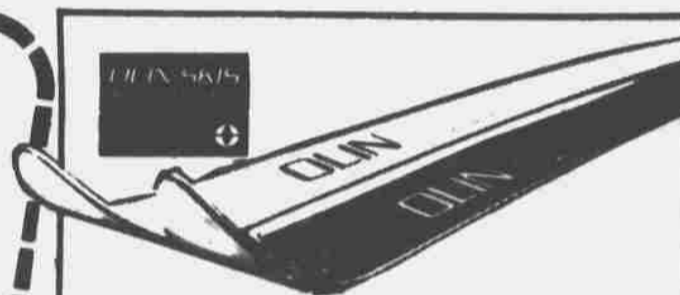
