Laura Campbell, wife of punter Grant Campbell, also has been to the Orange Bowl before and said she is looking forward to going back. She said she would like to take advantage of the sun and the warm weather and the free time while she is in Florida. Unlike the Mathisons, however, Campbell said her family makes Christmas plans around the Orange Bowl game.

Laura Mathison and Laura Campbell are considered veterans of the Orange Bowl scene. But many wives will be going for the first time. This will be Teresa Lyday's

first taste of the Orange Bowl, her first chance to ride a plane, and the opportunity to see the ocean for the first time all wrapped up in one trip.
