"Union City" is reminiscent of the "film noir" genre of the 1940s and '50s, with blinking neon lights radiating through dusty venetian blinds, casting shadows around the dark and drab apartment and adding color and a subtle sense of humor. Claustrophobia is felt as we view Harlan in his tiny accounting office, concocting his revenge for the milk thief, who has been leaving them half a bottle of milk for several mornings now. The red tint lighting during apartment scenes and at the bar


compliments Harlan's tension and anxiety and perhaps Lillian's frustrated passion.

Lillian has been seeing Larry, the maintenance man for the apartment, while Harlan has been away. She wants the simple things from life. Despite her desires, she revels in innocence and naivete.

"All I care about is you Larry," she says once. "Just going with you to the Friday matinee, and my flowers."

The film seems to move at a torpid rate, revealing Harlan inundated with guilt following a potentially fatal scuffle with the dreaded milk thief. The shots are long in between the edits, trapping the characters in one place for long periods of time, accenting the inner-city ennui and Harlan's psychological state. The problems with this film lie in the motivation between Lillian and Larry: Will things really get better?

Also starring Pat Benatar, Ireena Malveena, Everet McGill and Tony Azito,"Union City"boasts an impressive soundtrack, composed by "Blondie" guitarist Chris Stein.


