Nebraska scored two runs in the top of the first inning in the first game but the Jayhawks took a 3-2 lead in the bottom half of the inning on a home run by Kevin Bascue.

The Huskers got back the lead in the top of the second as they scored five runs. The inning was highlighted by home runs by Dan Boever.

In the fourth inning the Huskers came back to score eight runs on only one base hit. That base hit was a three-run homer by Reggie Dymally, his first of the year. That inning brought the score to the final of 15-4.

Jeff Anderson was the first game winner, improving his season mark to 6-0. Anderson gave up only five hits in the seven inning game. Nebraska was aided in the first game by 11 walks.

Kansas jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the second inning of the second game but Nebraska took the lead with two

runs in the top of the third. Kansas grabbed a 5-2 lead in the bottom of the fifth but Nebraska scored five in the top of the sixth to take a 7-5 lead.

Kansas scored three runs in the bottom of the sixth for the 8-7 victory. Ben Amaya picked up the loss for Nebraska in relief of Bob Sebra.

Nebraska will now take a 32-4 record into Tuesday's double-header with UNO. Kansas' record now stands at 13-14 after the weekend's action. The next Big Eight action for the Huskers will be Saturday and Sunday against Oklahoma.

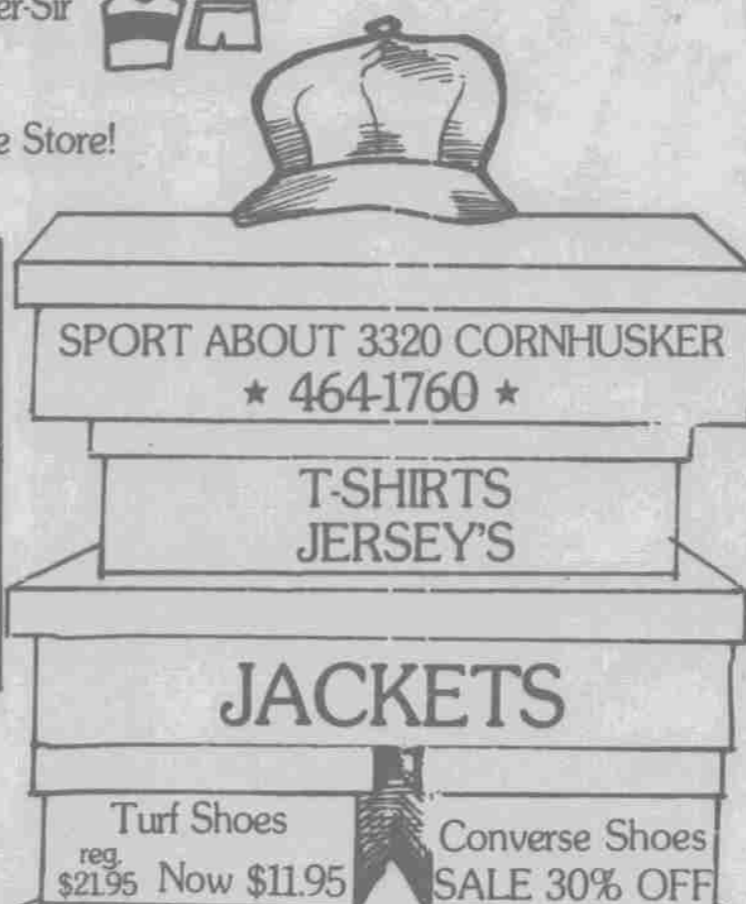
