Renovations

Love Library and Henzlik Hall auditoriums got a new look this summer. Seats in the library auditorium were re-upholstered, and instructors will have access to new visual aid machines. Cost of these improvements totaled slightly more than \$34,500.

At a cost of more than \$35,000, new seats, a videotape machine and six color monitors were installed in Henzlik auditorium.

The once-gravel parking lot out 1317 R St. has been hard-surfaced at an estimated cost of \$14,900. Funds were provided through the university parking fund.

Morrill Hall

Progress toward installing a climate control system in Morrill Hall has been slow. Lincoln Sen. Don Wesely, a strong supporter of a legislative climate control proposal, said a program has been drawn up describing the needs of the hall and the cost of LB410. Wesely said as far as he knew the program had not been forwarded to the NU Board of Regents.

"Apparently there are some problems delaying the transaction," Wesely said.

Morrill Hall is partially owned by the state.

Wesely said the university places a greater priority on renovating buildings that are under

its complete control.

Despite bureaucratic complications, Wesely has been assured Morrill Hall will have priority billing when the Legislature discusses university construction projects.

Veterinary Labs

The fate of one of UNL's three veterinary diagnostic labs, located near Scottsbluff, is in the hands of panhandle veterinarians and livestock producers.

Because of a limited budget of \$70,000 and less-than-capacity use of the station, university officials are considering closing it down.

Roy Arnold, vice chancellor for agriculture and natural resources, said return on investment will be a key factor in the decision. Officials agree that increased use of the panhandle station would be a point in its favor. The station handles about 600 cases per year.
