The dinner also came with a plentiful serving of fried rice. The fried rice at most oriental places in town is bland, sometimes dry and almost never interesting. This rice had flavor, was just right in consistency and the ingredients, including scrambled eggs, made it a cuisine curiosity.

The egg rolls at the Vien-Dong also were unique. They stood above every egg roll I have ever known, except the incredible egg rolls at the American-Chinese Cafe in Beatrice.

My friends enjoyed their lunch as well. One commended the snow peas and shrimp, while another espoused praise for the sweet and sour pork. The last one loved her egg drop soup, and I lamented that I had run out of adjectives to describe good food.

The prices at the Vien-Dong are very reasonable. The most expensive dinner dish costs \$4.95. The soups on the lunch menu run from \$1 to the \$2 range. Nguyen said the beef noodle, pork noodle and chicken noodle soup are all house specialties and are meals in themselves.

The service at Vien-Dong is first rate. Our waiter kept the tea coming and there was only a 15 minute wait for the main plates.

The Vien-Dong is open 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and 1 p.m. to 9 p.m. Sundays.
