### BIG EIGHT REPORT CARD

a C for a perfectly average effort against a superior team.

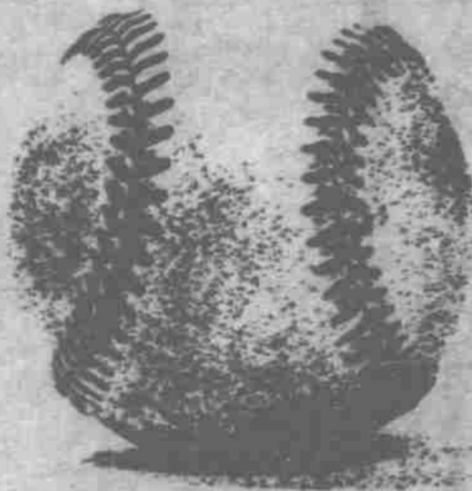
