The potent offense also is assured of at least tying the record for rushing touchdowns per game. Nebraska's 5.6 average is ahead of Oklahoma's record of 5.1 established in 1956. The Huskers need just one rushing touchdown against the Sooners to record a new mark.

Benefiting from the Nebraska scoring barrage, the Husker kickers have clinched a record of their own. Husker kicking specialists Dave Schneider, Scott Livingston, Mark Hagerman and Dan Wingard have combined to hit 73 of 81 extra-point attempts this season. Averaging 6.6 extra points per game, the Huskers easily have exceeded San Diego State's 1969 record average of 5.9.

The chart below lists the 1983 Huskers' records and near records.

Most Games Rushing 100 Yards or more, season (NCAA and Big Eight):

11 — Archie Griffin, Ohio State, 1974; Tony Dorsett, Pittsburgh, 1976; Terry Miller, Oklahoma State, 1977; George Rogers, South Carolina, 1980; Marcus Allen, Southern California, 1981; Herschel Walker, Georgia, 1981. (Mike Rozier has 10).

Highest Average Gain Per Rush, Career (NCAA and Big Eight): (Minimum 500 rushes) 7.087 yards — Billy Sims, Oklahoma, 1975-79 (538 for 3,813). (Rozier is at 7.19 on 636 for 4,575.)

Highest Average Gain Per Rush, Career (NCAA): (Min. 650 rushes) 6.13 yards — Griffin, Ohio State, 1972-75, on 845 for 5,177. (Rozier is at 7.19 on 636 for 4,575.)

Most Yards Rushing, Season (Big Eight): 1,877 — Ernest Anderson, Oklahoma State, 1982. (Rozier has 1,943).

Most Rushing Yards, Career (Big Eight): 4,582 — Miller, Oklahoma State, 1974-77. (Rozier has 4,575.)

Highest Average Per Rush, Season (Big Eight): (Min. 250 rushes) 5.75 yards — Miller, Oklahoma State, 1976 (268 for 1,541). (Rozier is at 8.0 on 243 for 1,943.)

Most Touchdowns Scored by Rushing, Season (NCAA): 26 — Lydell Mitchell, Penn State, 1971 (per-game record is 2.67 by Ed Marinaro of Cornell, 1971, on 24 in 9). (Rozier has 28 — 2.54 per game.)

Most Yards Gained Rushing vs. One Opponent, Career (NCAA): (Three games) 601 — Marinaro, Cornell, vs. Pennsylvania, 1969-71 (114 rushes).

(Rozier gained 584 yards on 63 carries vs. Kansas State, 1981-83, 17 yards short of the record.)

Lowest Percentage of Passes Intercepted, Career (NCAA): (Min. 300 attempts.) 2.56 percent — Paul McDonald, Southern California, 1976-79 (12 of 468). (Turner Gill is at 2.43 percent, on 10 of 412 from 1980-83.) Big Eight record is 3.27 percent by Jerry Tagge, Nebraska, 1969-71, on 19 of 581.)

Most Yards Gained Per Passing Attempt, Career (Big Eight): (Min. 400 atts) 8.10 — Tagge, Nebraska, 1969-71, on 581 for 4,704. (Gill is at 7.91 on 412 for 3,259.)

Most Passing Yards Gained Per Completion, Career (Big Eight): (Min. 200 Comp.): 14.46 — Steve Pisarkiewicz, Missouri, 1974-76, on 236 for 3,413. (Gill is at 14.55 on 224 for 3,259.)

Most Touchdown Passes Caught, Season (Big Eight): 11 — Johnny Rodgers, Nebraska, 1971. (Irving Fryar has 8.)

Highest Average Gained Per Pass Reception, Season (Big Eight): (Min. 40 receptions): 21.5 yards — Henry Marshall, Missouri, 1975, on 44 for 945 yards. (Fryar is at 20.9 on 36 for 753.)

Most Touchdowns Scored, Season (NCAA): 29 — Mitchell, Penn State, 1971 (per-game record is 2.67 by Ed Marinaro, Cornell, 1971, 24 in 9.) (Rozier has 24 in 1983 — 2.54 per game.)

Most Points Scored, Season (Big Eight): 157 — Bobby Reynolds, Nebraska, 1950 (9 games). (Rozier has 168.)

Most Total Offense Yards Gained Per Game, Season (NCAA & Big Eight): 566.5 — Oklahoma, 1971 (6,232 in 11). (Nebraska is at 557.8 in 11.)

Most Touchdowns Rushing and Passing Per Game, Season (NCAA & Big Eight): 6.4 — Oklahoma, 1956 (64 in 10). (Nebraska is at 7.7 in 1983 — 85 in 11.)

Most Touchdowns Rushing Per Game, Season (NCAA & Big Eight): 5.1 — Oklahoma, 1956; Texas, 1969, 1970 (each 51 in 10). (Nebraska is at 5.6, needs to score one more touchdown to clinch breaking the record.)

Highest Average Gain Per Pass Attempt, Season (NCAA): (Min. 200 atts.) 9.88 yards — Brigham Young, 1980 (498 for 4,918). (Nebraska is at 9.56 on 176 for 1,682.)

Highest Passing Efficiency Rating Points, Season

(NCAA): (Min. 150 atts.) 170.6 — Brigham Young, 1980 (498 att., 317 comp., 21 int., 4,918 yards, 49 TDs). (Nebraska is at 165.2 on 176 att., 100 comp., 5 int., 1,682 yards, 18 TDs.)

Most Points Scored, Season (NCAA): 560 — Brigham Young, 1980 (12 games). (Nebraska has 596 points.)

Most Extra Points Made by Kicking Per Game (NCAA): 5.9 — San Diego State, 1969 (59 in 10, attempted 60). (Nebraska is 6.6, 73 in 11, attempted 81.)

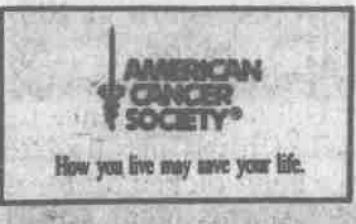
