Fund A refunds total \$1,411.94

A total of \$1,411.94 was returned to 279 UNL students who requested Fund A refunds for University Programs and Facility Fees this semester, said Doug Metzger, manager of the Student Activities and Financial Services office.

The number of students requesting refunds decreased by 55 from last year's fall semester total, Metzger said. The refund amount decreased \$210.90.

All full-time students' tuition statements included \$88.20 in student fees this semester. Beginning in May 1980, the NU Board of Regents authorized a refund opportunity for Fund A, which totaled \$5.16 per student this semester. However, Fund B fees, which totaled \$83 per student this semester, are not refundable.

Fund A fees go to student organizations such as the Association of Students of the University of Nebraska, the Daily Nebraskan, the University Program Council and the Nebraska State Student Association. Fund B represents institutional obligations and

student service agencies. These include debt service, the University Health Center and the Nebraska and East unions.

Students who request Fund A refunds lose some benefits associated with the student organizations. These lost benefits include ASUN's free legal services, the Daily Nebraskan's student discounts for classified advertisements and some of UPC's student-priced tickets for films, concerts and other activities.

While 476 students picked up Fund A refund forms at the Student Activities and Financial Services office, only 332 returned their completed forms, Metzger said. Only 279 of the 332 students picked up their refunds.

Metzger said students have an option to request a total or partial refund of Fund A fees. He said most students took a total refund this semester.

The \$5.16 refund breaks down into \$1.34 for ASUN, 90 cents for the Daily Nebraskan, \$2.42 for UPC and 50 cents for NSSA.
