Huskers vie with Cyclones in swim dual

Nebraska men's swimming Coach Cal Bentz would like to see the Huskers continue their recent mastery of Iowa State in their 3 p.m. Saturday dual in the Sports Center pool, but he'd also like his team to gain consistency.
"Coming off a weekend

with two losses, we need to win," Bentz said. "We need to swim faster and get more consistent performances."
The ISU dual will serve

as an indicator for the remainder of the season, Bentz said.

The Huskers have defeated Iowa State in duals the past two seasons, although the Cyclones lead the 56-meet series 47-9.

"Nebraska and Iowa State began as the leaders in the conference," Bentz said. "Iowa State then became the dominant team through much of the history of our sport in the conference."

A pair of returning Big
Eight champions enhance
the Cyclones' chances. Senior Bart Thomas is a twotime champion in the 100meter breaststroke, while sophomore Scott McCadam won the 100 freestyle title.

Bentzsaid Nebraska swim mers won't be attempting to qualify for the NCAA championships in Saturday's dual.

"We're not in a position where we can qualify unshaved, and we're not go-

ing to shave," he said.
At 1-3, "our dual season looks pretty bleak,"
Bentz said. "A win brings us to 2-3 on the year. It's important in that respect."
