Merlene Ottey leads Husker Invitational field

Nebraska's world-class sprinter Merlene Ottey from Jamaica will headline a list of athletes scheduled to compete in the 10th annual Husker Invitiational this Saturday at the Bob Devaney Sports Center's indoor track.

Ottey, who will compete for the first time this indoor season, is slated to run in the 60- and 440yard dashes.

"We're not really looking for great things from Merlene this meet," Coach Gary Pepin said. This is the first meet of the season for her and we haven't been gearing her workouts for this meet. The most important thing for her right now is the (Olympic) games so she has been training more for that."

The non-scoring relay meet regularly draws some of the country's best athletes and Pepin said distance medley relay is 1984 should be no different.

Nebraska, Brigham Young, Nevada-Las Vegas, Florida State and Texas are the strongest of the 12 women's teams competing, while Villanova, Southern California, Iowa State, Missouri and Nebraska will highlight the 10-team men's field.

With Villanova making its annual visit to the Husker Invitational, the expected to become the featured event. The Wildcats set the collegiate record of 9:35.37 at the Sports Center two years ago.

For Nebraska, Glen Cunningham will run the halfmile, Dennis Wallace the quarter, Gerard O'Callaghan the three-quarters and Marc Adam the mile.

"The primary objective for this meet, as far as we're concerned, is to get our people qualified for nationals, Pepin said. And our distance medley relay team has a good chance of doing that."

Pepin said both his men's and women's teams should be at full strength Saturday. The only exception may be Nebraska's Angela Thacker, who isn't expected to long jump because of a sore knee. The field events will begin at noon.




