Boxer's fists run out of punch

UNL super-heavyweight boxer Carl Von Rein won the Southeast District Golden Gloves Jan. 18 uncontested.

No one could be found to fight him.

Saturday night, Von Rein got his fights at the Midwest Golden Gloves Championships in Omaha.

He dropped Bob Starr of the Central District with a blow to his chin 53 seconds into the first round. Von Rein knocked Starr out in last year's Midwest championships as well. Starr said Von Rein has improved.

In the championship out, the last on the card Von Rein boxed Stan Holan of Norfolk, who, according to UNL Coach Randy Nelson, "is tough as barn wood — he can weather anything."

Holan weathered several of Von Rein's left hooks and powerful rights and won the bout with jabs and endurance.

Nelson said Von Rein won the first round scoring with several punches to Holan's midsection and face. But Holan kept Von Rein at bay in the next two rounds with jabs. Von Rein "ran out of steam," Nelson said. Holan won by decision.

Poor conditioning contributed to Von Rein's loss, Nelson said. "He didn't have any wind...he doesn't run," he said.


Nelson said Von Rein, a junior, would fight again next year.

Dan Lonowski was the only other UNL boxer to make the Midwest championship trip. Bobby Bates of Norfolk won a technical knockout against Lonowski after Lonowski broke his hand.

A crowd of 3,940 people watched the fights at Omaha's Civic Auditorium. Two fights occurred between spectators. No one was injured.
