Magical antics of Globetrotters make G-rated fun

The magical wizardry of the Harlem Globetrotters comes to Lincoln Saturday at Pershing Auditorium.

The Globetrotters are known for their antics, which highlight crowd participation. They will play the Washington Generals, coached by Red Klotts, in a 7:30 p.m. game.

The Globetrotters lineup includes such familiar names as Geese Ausbie, Jimmy Blacklock, Clyde Austin and Sweet Lou Dunbar.

Though they are known for their crazy antics, the Globetrotters have won 98 percent of their games. They have an all-time win-loss record of 15,565-331. They have not lost a game since Jan. 5, 1971, when they were defeated in Martin, Tenn., 100-99 by the Generals.

If the Globetrotters could be described in one word, Coach Tex Harrison said it would be fun.

"First, we're G-rated, and there aren't a lot of things around that are," he said. "But what it basically comes down to is that sometime during the game, whether you are a basketball fan or not, we're going to do something to make you happy."

Tickets range from \$5.50 to \$8.50 and are on sale until game time.
