

Blum, Trumble named 1984 student leaders

When Steve Blum and Mary Trumble came to UNL as freshmen they didn't plan on getting actively involved in campus affairs.

But they did and Friday they were named winners of the 1984 Scribner-Hunter Student Leadership Award.

Dean of Students David DeCoster said the award is given annually to the two male and female students on campus who have displayed the most leadership in their years at UNL. The winners must also be juniors.

DeCoster said the award is voted on by both students and UNL educators. He said about two dozen participate in the voting.

Blum and Trumble were pleased by the award.

"I was very excited," Blum, a member of Lambda Chi fraternity, said. "It's a great honor because it's voted on by both your peers and by adults."

"I was really surprised to get it," Trumble said. "I feel very honored."

Both Blum and Trumble said they started their activities with involvement in only a couple of groups.

"I just got in a couple of activities and really liked it," Blum said. "From there I just got into other activities."

"Once you get involved in one thing you kind of get pulled into others," Trumble said.

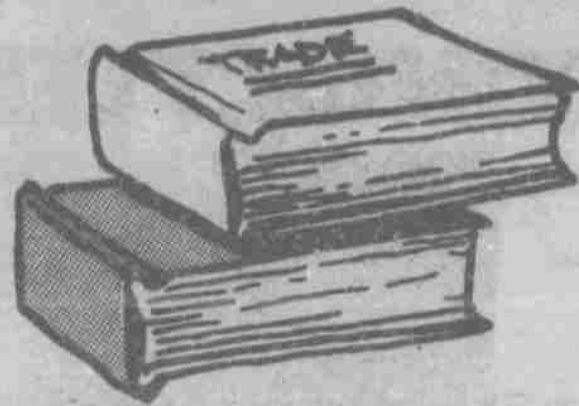
Trumble, a member of Alpha Chi Omega sorority, said her involvement in campus activities has enabled her to put skills she learned in the classroom to a practical use.

"Things like communication skills, organizational skills, those things are something you can read about but you have to be able to apply them to real situations."

Trumble's honors include University Program Council-East Visual Arts Chairperson, New Student Orientation Host, and a Regents Scholarship.

Blum's honors include president of the Student Alumni Association, Business College Student Advisory Board, and a two time membership on the CBA's Dean's List.

HERE'S HOW!

Q. How does the University Bookstore determine how much my books are worth when I sell them back?

A. If the bookstore has notification from the instructor that the book is to be re-adopted for the next semester, and if the bookstore does not already have a sufficient stock on hand, then the student will be offered 60% of the publisher's current list price. For instance, a book which currently sells for \$10.00 new, and which meets the requirements noted above would be worth \$6.00. It would be resold the next semester for \$7.50.

If the bookstore has not received notice that the book will be used again, or if it already has a sufficient stock, the book would be worth the current wholesale price as indicated by one of the nation's largest jobbers of used textbooks. The buyer will be happy to answer any questions which you may have regarding the price paid.

Q. Is sixty percent the usual price paid for textbooks around the country?

A. Definitely not! Most stores in the United States pay only 50 percent for books being used again. The University Bookstore is one of only a very few which pay 60 percent. And remember we pay cash.

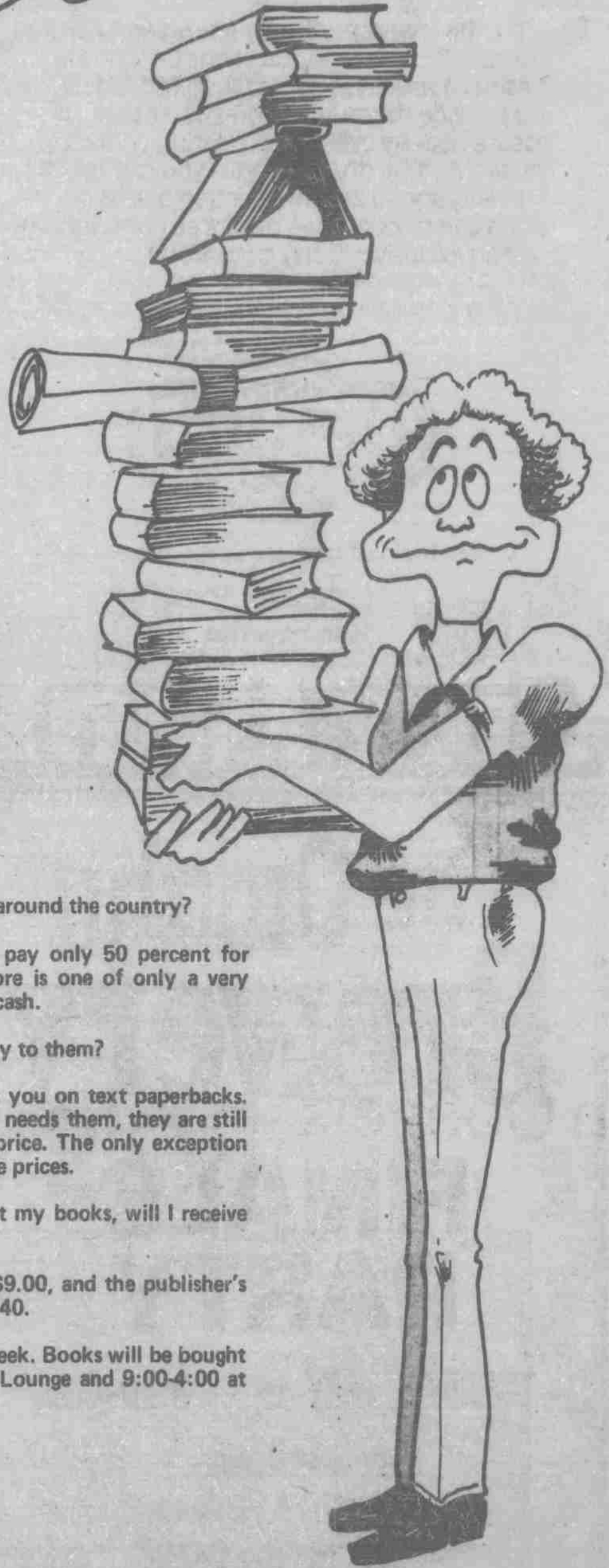
Q. What about paperbacks? Does the same policy apply to them?

A. Yes. The University Bookstore does not penalize you on text paperbacks. If they are being used again, and if the bookstore needs them, they are still worth 60 percent of the publisher's current list price. The only exception is English paperbacks which are bought at wholesale prices.

Q. If the publisher's price had gone up since I bought my books, will I receive the benefit of that price increase?

A. Yes. For instance, if you bought your book for \$9.00, and the publisher's list price is now \$10.00, you will get \$6.00, not \$5.40.
