when it is the setting for a summer concert series sponsored by the Lincoln Center Association.

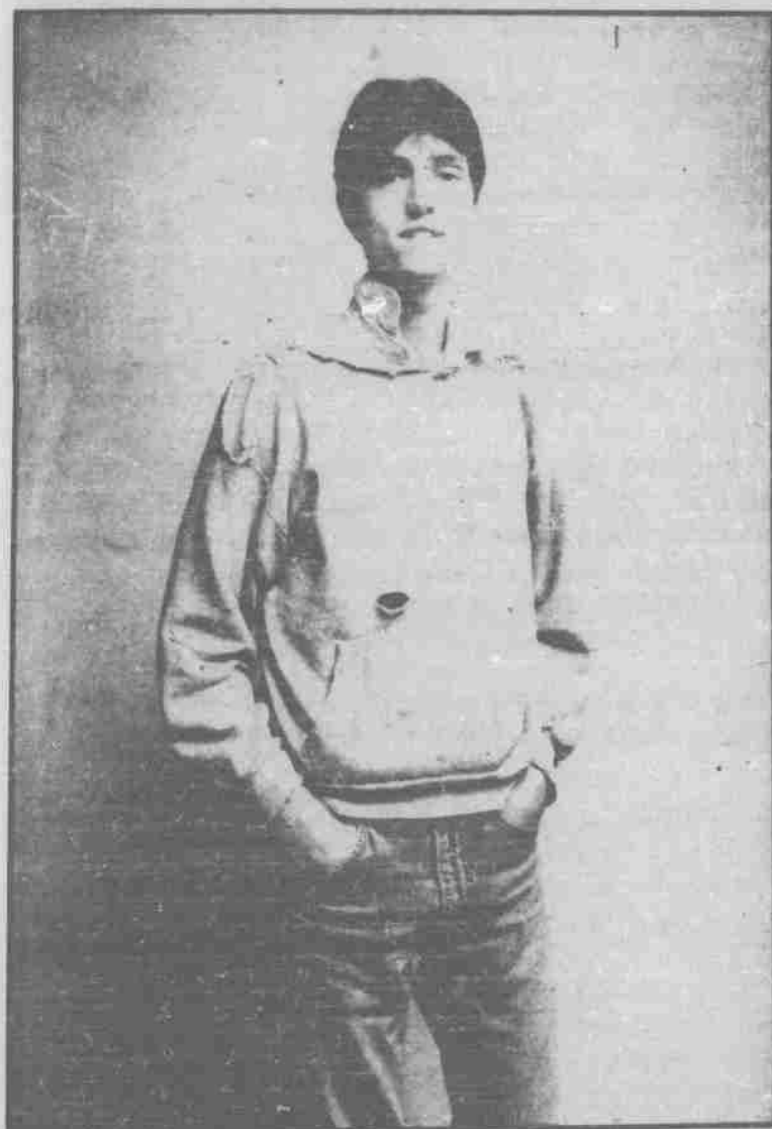

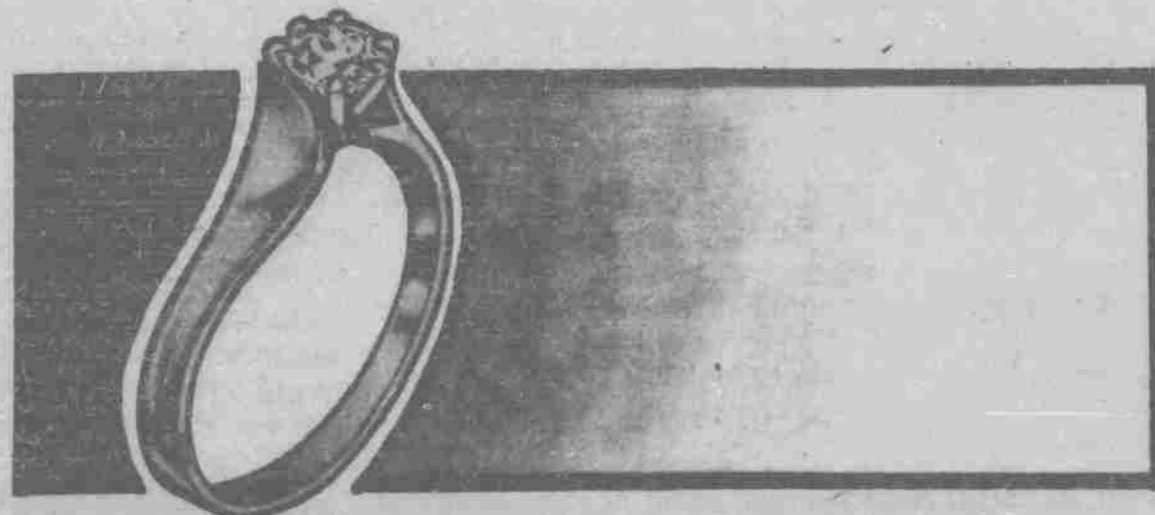
