# UCLA ousts Huskers in College World Series

Omaha - If it hadn't been for Jennifer Sim, coach Wayne Daigle's strategy would have worked perfectly for Nebraska.

With Winsberg on third and two outs, Daigle elected to intentionally walk Bruins Sheila Cornell and Barbara Young, thus loading the bases.

Sim, batting 313 in the series, then laced Mori Emmons' first pitch past the outstretched arms of second baseman Lori Rich-

Daigle said he ordered the walks to set up a force play at any base, but "she (Emmons) just threw the wrong pitch to the wrong batter."

Winsberg had reached base on Emmon's first walk of the game, and advanced on a sacrifice

bunt by Mary Ricks and a ground out by designated hitter Tricia Mang.

"We had chances early," Daigle said, "but we didn't get the run across."

After leaving the bases full in the second inning, Nebraska squandered another scoring opportunity in the fifth inning with help from UCLA's All-American pitcher Debbie Doom.

Consecutive singles by Denise Feldhaus and Peg Richardson preceeded a sacrifice bunt by Cindy Aerni. UCLA coach Sharron Backus then replaced starting pitcher Tracy Compton with Doom.

. The Bruin junior struck out Ann Schroeder, then got Wendy Turner to bounce back to her.

Compton had pitched out of the second-inning jam by striking out Aerni

"I think UCLA was uptight, especially in the early innings," Daigle said.

Sterling defensive plays by Denise Eckert and Richins stopped Bruin rallies in the fourth and fifth innings.

With runners at second and third bases in the fourth inning and one out, Eckert fielded a hard-hit ball by Young, looked at the runners and threw to first. Sim then grounded out to Emmons.

Richins barely squeezed a poor throw from Emmons with two outs in the fifth to retire Ricks at first base. The play also occurred with runners at second and third.

"To copy a quote," Daigle said, "I'm not so sure we lost but that we just ran
