

## Diverse athletes...

Lewis Meyers of Richardson, Texas and Alvin Spencer of Long Beach, California will compete for the men's team while Julie May of Denver and Sherri Birmingham of Omaha will dive for the women's team.

Huber said this year's class was "potentially my best." "We were able to go head-to-head with Florida and Indiana for Lewis Meyers. That's the first time we've won one of those battles," Huber said. "Alvin Spencer and Julie May are both extremely talented, but have had only limited amounts of training at this time. Both should really prosper in our program. Sherri Birmingham needs some work, but she'll get the chance to grow in our program and I think she'll begin to realize her true potential."

All four divers have impressive credentials. Meyers was runner-up in the Texas state championships in addition to qualifying last year for the junior nationals.

Spencer, although he has been diving for only 18 months, finished second in the California high school championships.

May is a three-time state champion in Colorado, while Birmingham qualified all four years for the Nebraska state meet while competing for Omaha Marian. She finished fourth as a senior.

## Nebraska signs two swimming recruits

Nebraska women's swimming coach Ray Huppert has announced the signing of two more recruits, Penny Stanek of Omaha and Renee Coffman of Rockville, Maryland, to national letters of intent to compete for Nebraska next fall.

Stanek was a state champion in the 100 backstroke last season for Omaha Gross, where she was also the Metro Conference 100 backstroke champion and an academic All-metro selection. "We are thrilled that Penny has decided to swim for us next season," Huppert said. "We feel that her potential is limitless and she'll have a good chance to develop over the next four years."

Coffman was a junior national qualifier in the breaststroke events, but has only been swimming in a year-round program for a short time. "Renee's father is in the Foreign Service and she has lived in many different countries, so she's never been able to really train for a long period of time," Huppert said. "She'll add a great amount of quality to our breaststroke events next season and we feel that she has a lot to offer our program."

These two signings bring to four the number of athletes that Huppert has signed this spring.
