

## North defeats South

Shrine Bowls have a history of being low scoring and Saturday's game was no exception. The North defeated the South 14-0, thanks mainly to turnovers that kept the South from cashing in on several scoring chances.

The South had three fumbles and an interception — actually one less than the North — but the South chose very inopportune times to play giveaway.

The South was driving for a touchdown early in the second quarter when Keith Jones of Omaha Central fumbled at the North's 25-yard line.

North quarterback Ross Els of Lincoln Northeast High School returned the favor on the next play as he threw an interception to Anthony Whalls of Omaha's Westside High School. The South was in business once again, but not for long.

Jones once again fumbled, this time losing the ball at the North 21.

That turnover led to the North's first score as quarterback Jim Toner of Grand Island capped a nine-play drive with a one-yard run. The big play on the drive was a 42-yard run by Kevin Trooper, also of Grand Island.

The South had one more good chance to score when they recovered a fumble at the North 14. They moved it from there to the two where they had first and goal but the going was tough from there. Two running plays netted only a yard and quarterback John Dostal fumbled on the next play.

The North scored their last touchdown in the third quarter after Tim Knust of Creighton prep picked off a pass and returned it to the South six-yard line. That turnover quickly led to a score as Omaha Burke's Elton Edmond scored from the three.
