**University Theatre, Temple Building, 12th and R streets.**

- Hours: Box office 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. All shows start at 8 p.m.
- Admission: Monday through Thursday, \$4 students, children and senior citizens, \$5 general. Friday and Saturday, \$4.50 students, children and senior citizens, \$5.50 general.
- Fall features: Mass Appeal, Aug. 31; Sept. 1, and Sept. 6 through 8. Betrayal, Open ing show Oct. 4. The Hostage, Opening show Oct. 25. Complete schedules are available at the box office.

**UNL State Museum, 14th and U streets.**

- Hours: 8 p.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m., Sunday.
- Admission: free
- Features: Elephant Hall, same hours as museum; Encounter Room, 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday and Sunday; Planetarium show, 2:30 p.m. daily with additional shows at 3:45 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.
