The Big Eight also signed a contract with Katz Sports, a New York syndicator, for a 12game package that is reportedly worth between \$1.5 million and \$3.5 million. Each game would

have a late-morning kickoff on Saturdays.

Up to five Nebraska games might be seen this fall on ABC, ESPN and Katz

None of Nebraska's games are listed on either the ABC or ESPN schedules. Katz is tenatively televising the Huskers' Sept. 29 game at Syracuse, and the game's kickoff time has been reset to allow for a telecast.

ABC Sports publicist Donn

Bernstein told the Omaha World-Herald last week that the network is considerig televising Ne-braska's Nov. 17 home game

with Oklahoma.

Katz has listed Nebraska's Oct. 6 game with Okiahoma State and its Oct. 13 game with Missouri on its tenative schedule. It also scheduled the Huskers' Nov. 3 contest at Iowa State, but the telecast has been dropped following a statement by Devaney that Nebraska will not appear more than three times in the Katz package.

In the order for telecast priorities, ABC has first chance to televise games involving CFA schools. ESPN may then choose, followed by regional syndicators such as Katz.

CFA schools are eligible for three appearances on ABC this season. They may not appear more than once on ESPN if they reach the three appearance limit.
