The intentions are mainly pure and honest, until a third psychic is needed. Enter Alex Gardner (Dennis Quaid), a teen psychic phenomenon who dropped out of the testing process to become a wizard on the race track and pick girls to go after.  
It's a dangerous life, though, because the track rats know he has the knack of picking winners. Forever on the run, Gardner ends up back in the laboratory, working on the dreamscape theory with his former doctor, Paul Novotny (Max Van Sydnow).  
Gardner picks up the power to enter dreams with or without Novotny's machine. But rival psycho psychic, also has the power. Therival's government heavy (Christopher Plummer) puts him on a direct life and death course with Gardner and the U.S. president (Eddie Albert). The rival psycho

played by David Patrick Kelly, is the best actor in the movie.  
The makers of Dreamscape want viewers to think about the possibilities of such ability, which the press release says "is in the not-too-distant future." If someone has the power to enter your dreams — the most private part of anyone — what changes could it mean? Then, if that power falls into the wrong hands, be they incompetent or evil, then what? Also, if it's possible to kill someone in a dream, will that person also die in real life?  
If you buy it at all, or just enough to sense a danger from Plummer's character (and the CIA for that matter) then "Dreamscape" will be a rare adventure. If not, it will be hard to ignore and forgive Capshaw's brainless beauty bit, or the you-know-what-happens next feeling in the concluding pivotal dream.


