

Osborne pleased with team

Nebraska coach Tom Osborne said Wednesday he is pleased with his team's progress as the Cornhuskers prepare for Saturday's season opener against the Wyoming Cowboys.

"I think we've got a pretty good team," Osborne said. "But I don't know about No. 2 in the nation."

The Huskers are ranked second in the AP and UPI polls, behind defending national champion Miami.

Osborne sent the Cornhuskers through a light contact workout Wednesday.

Defensive tackle Rob Stuckey, who strained a knee in practice Tuesday, didn't participate Wednesday and probably won't play Saturday, Osborne said.

Stuckey's injury leaves Nebraska without much depth in the defensive line, he said.

"That hurts," Osborne said. "It looked like we were developing a little depth there."

Jim Skow is scheduled to start in place of Stuckey. Skow, a 6-3, 235-pound junior, saw lots of action in 1983, garnering 22 tackles. Senior Mike Zierke and junior Rod Reynolds will provide backup help, Osborne said.
