**Happold fund reductions thwart student career opportunities**

The schism between student reportage and student editors is illustrated by the headline choice for the piece appearing in Friday's Daily Nebraskan ("Sociology department reduces research funds," Page 3) on the reduction of Happold funds for graduate student travel. I would like to point out that the loss of these travel monies is a blow to all graduate students in the social sciences, encompassing considerably more disciplines than sociology. The program was not so much a "perk" as a necessity in today's competitive academic market. Most graduate students do not travel extensively, in large part because we cannot afford the expense. Happold funds enabled our travel to at least one yearly conference to present research and interview for positions in our respective disciplines. Graduate students receive little support for our work as it is, and the removal of these funds constitutes a real hardship for stu-

dents who live on a small monthly stipend.

It would be less than honest to say that I have not had "fun" at previous conferences I've attended. However, presentation of one's own work and interviewing for job openings falls more suitably under the heading of professional activities. An institution is judged in part on where its students are

placed. Placement, in turn, depends upon professional involvement and visibility. I would be willing to talk about "luxuries" if and when myself and other graduate students and staff at UNL have something called "discretionary income."
