Union's gourmet coffees perk up bakery business

Students walking through the Nebraska Student Union are perking up at the aroma of freshly-brewed gourmet coffee wafting from the Union Bakery.

Along with Cappuccino and Espresso, customers now can enjoy kenya AA, French roast, Columbian supreme, chocolate menthe, black forest chocolate and Amaretto. Coffee can be bought by the

cup, as whole beans or ground. Each day the union brews two varieties from its list of gourmet coffees that sell for 45 cents a cup and \$1.35 for one-quarter pound of beans or ground coffee. Cappuccino and Espresso are 75 cents a cup.

The bakery began selling gourmet coffee last April, said Carole Penas, assistant food service manager of production for the union. The idea was introduced by the Coffee Development Group,

she said. The Coffee Development Group loaned the necessary machines to the Union, Penas said. All the Union had to do was buy the coffee, which is purchased from McGarvey Coffee in Minneapolis, she said.

The CDG describes itself as a non-profit organization "dedicated to increasing the consumption of coffee by promoting a quality cup of coffee."

Business in the bakery has increased by about 30 percent since the gourmet coffees were added to the menu, Penas said.

Recently, the Union tried to "brew up a little excitement" about the special coffees by offering free coffee and cookies in the union lobby.

"Many students who don't know what it tastes like aren't apt to buy a cup," Penas said.

But Penas said she received many favorable comments and students seemed to like the flavors.

In addition to coffee tasting, the promotion sponsored a contest to see who could guess the number of coffee beans in a jar.

Three people spent about one hour counting the jar of 16,248 coffee beans for the contest, Penas said.

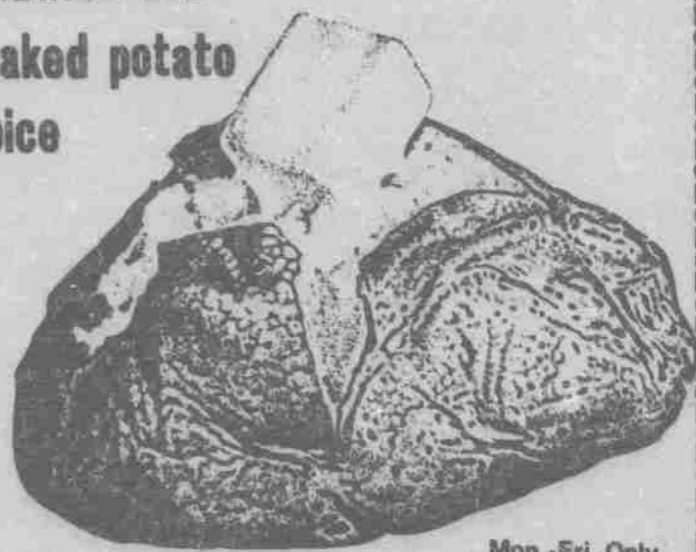

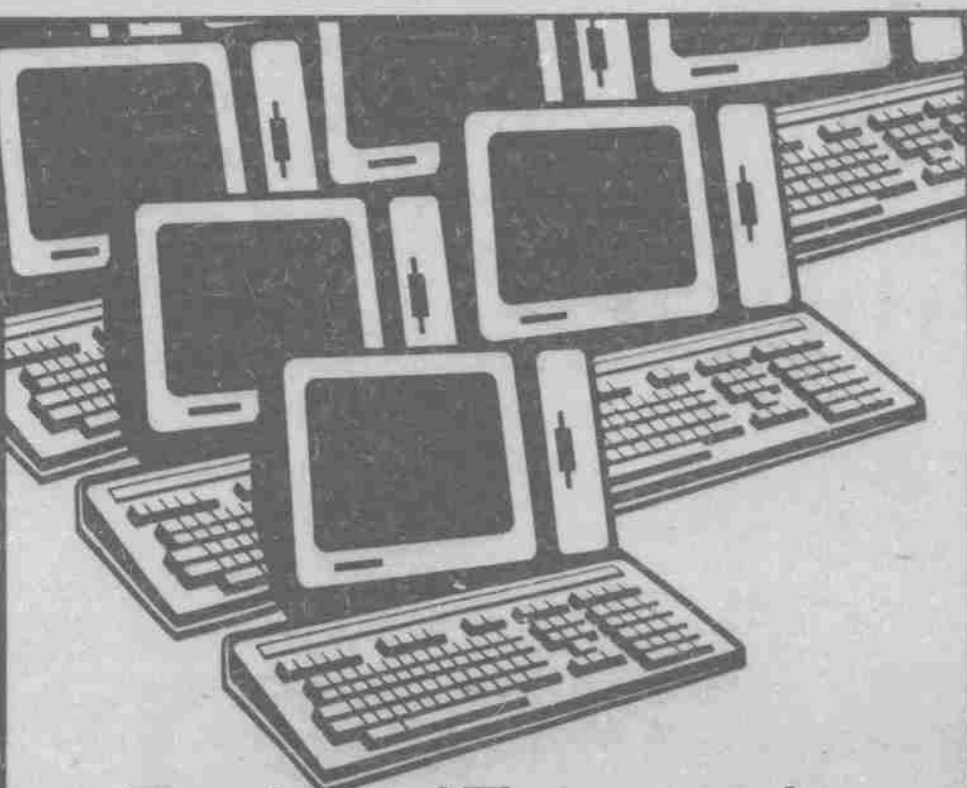
