

Husker women's softball team falls one run short in championship game

The women's softball team fell one run short of winning the Illinois State Invitational. Oklahoma State, who the Huskers beat to win last year's NCAA regional, defeated Nebraska 1-0 in the championship game. It was the season's first action for both teams.

"I would rather lose to Oklahoma State now than later on in the season when it really means something," coach Wayne Daigle said.

The Cornhuskers were 3-2 in the tournament. Their other loss was to Illinois State, which won

3-0 in eight innings. Freshman Lori Sipple had 13 strikeouts in the game.

The Huskers opened the tournament by beating Oklahoma State 2-0. Mori Emmons was the winning pitcher.

Saturday morning the Huskers beat Missouri 2-1. Donna Dear-dorff was the winning pitcher and Sipple got the save.

Daigle said Sipple pitched excellent softball throughout the tournament. She tallied more than 27 innings, had 26 strikeouts and allowed only three runs and three hits.

Sipple pitched a no-hitter against Illinois State in the semifinal, which the Huskers won 2-0.

Denise Eckert led the team in batting with a .533 average. She was eight for 15 with one home run and one run batted in.

Heidi Schlabach was four of 13 for an average of .308, with one home run and one run batted in.

The Huskers travel to Iowa State this weekend for the Iowa State Invitational, and return to host the Husker Invitational Sept. 28-31 at Mabel Lee field.
