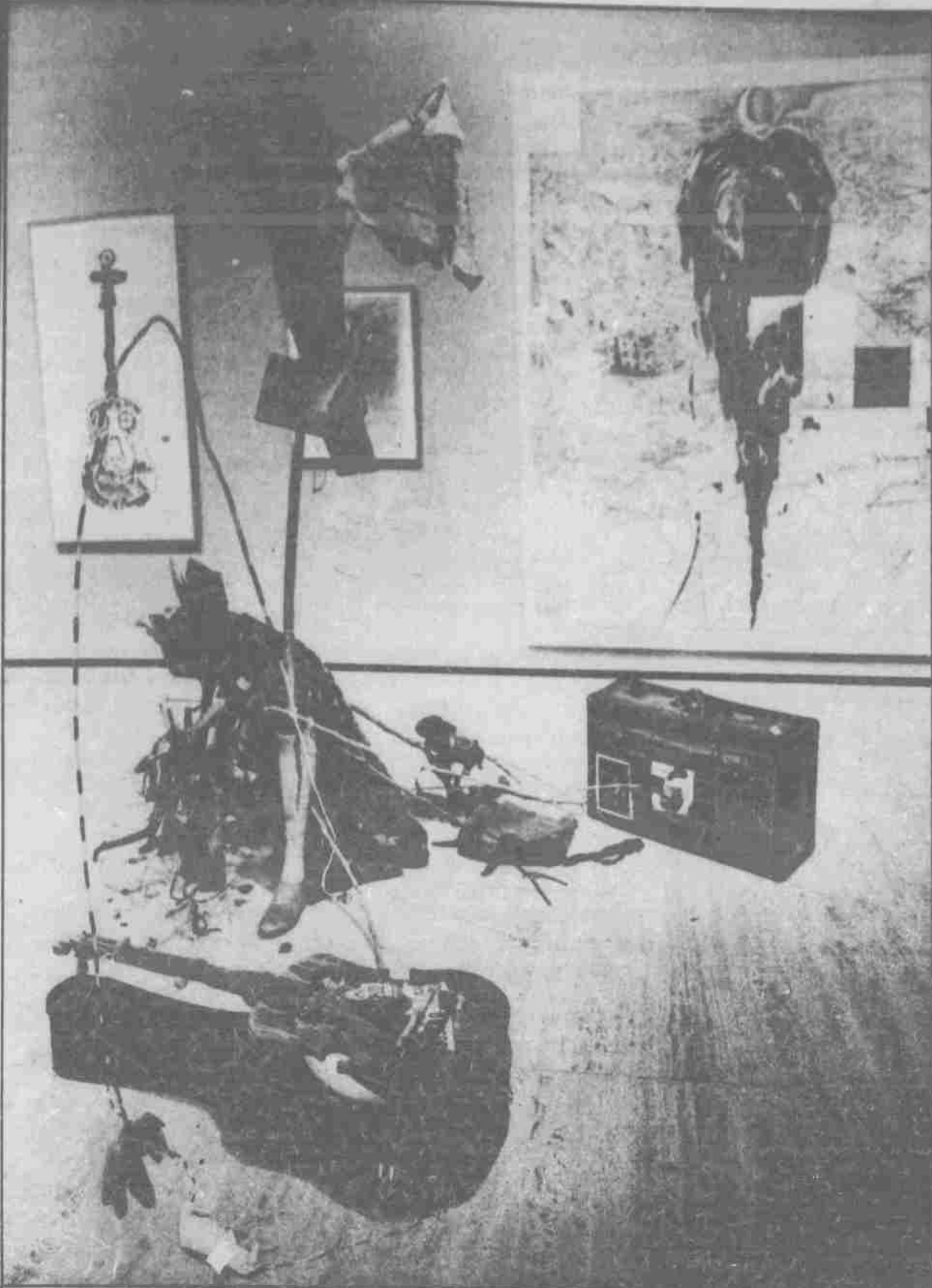

The work of 36 Bay Area artists represent a diverse cross-section of individual styles and movements that have influenced the artists.

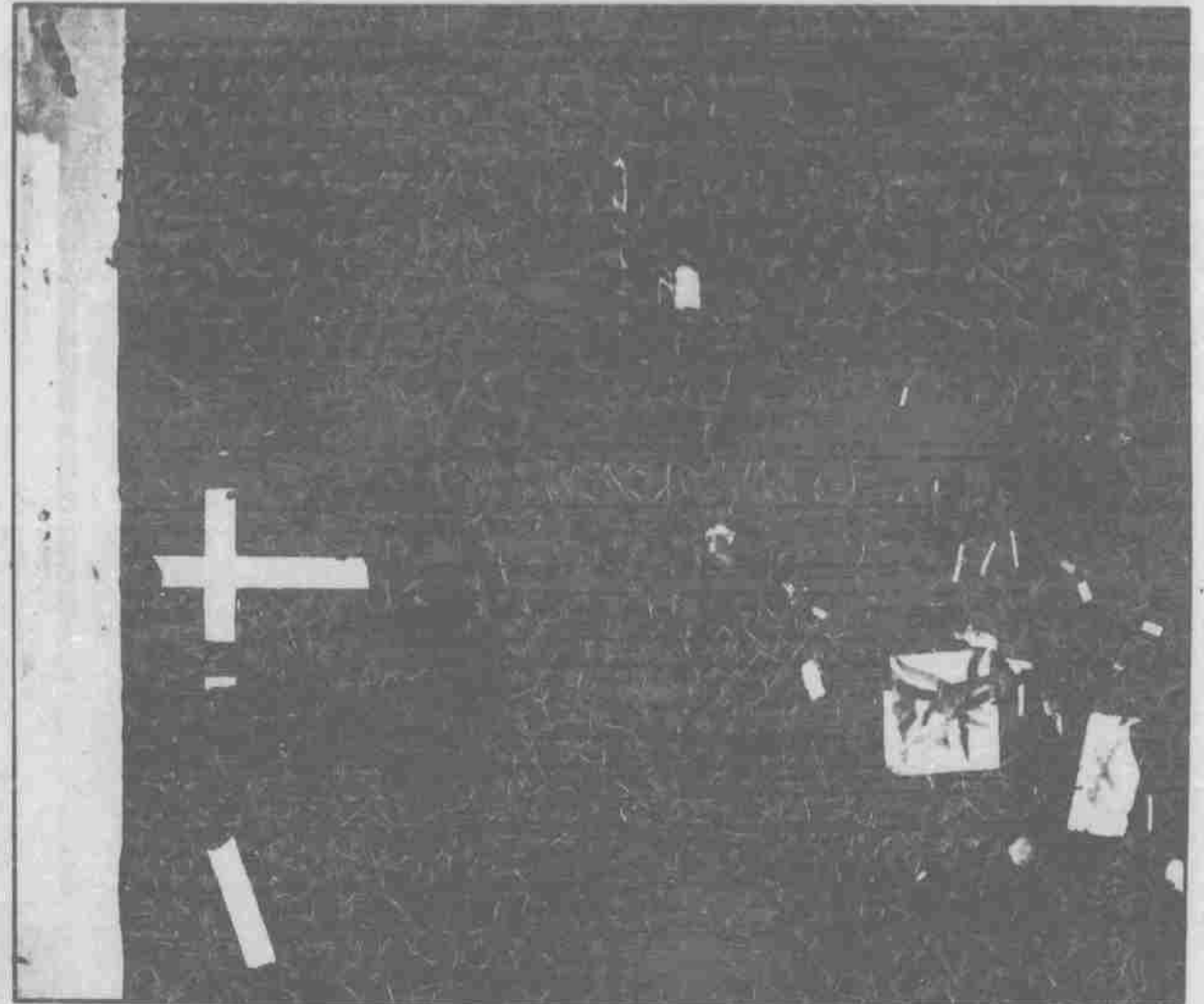
