

# Red Cross fund-raiser set for NU-Kansas State game

Saturday's Cornhusker football game against Kansas State will be the site of a Red Cross First Aid Team Appreciation Day, Steve Lewis, Red Cross director of Financial Development and Public Relations, said.

"Players get the first aid attention they need," Lewis said, "and because of our 56 First Aid Team volunteers, the fans do, too. Since this service has been provided to the fans without charge for many years, UNL and the Lancaster Country Red Cross are jointly sponsoring the second annual First Aid Team Appreciation Day.

"Last year's appreciation day wasn't as successful as hoped," Lewis said. "Red Cross raised \$1,600 at the game, an average of two cents per person." Lewis said to continue this service, the Red Cross would need to raise \$10,000 at the game.

Donations collected before, during and after the game will go for the extensive 17 hours of First Aid and CPR training the volunteers must pass, plus the annual First Aid and CPR competency tests. Besides training, the Red Cross uses donations for First Aid supplies used at the two First Aid stations at the stadium, for stretchers, helmets, jackets, uniforms and transportation.

Lewis said it has been suggested that the Red Cross "charge the university for our First Aid Team services, but if possible, we don't want to set a precedent of charging. That's why we need the NU fans' support this Saturday."

Lincoln Mayor Roland Luedtke on Oct. 17, proclaimed the week of Oct. 21 to 27 as "Red Cross Emergency First Aid Team Week." Luedtke also presented two First Aid Team members with certificates of appreciation. Leonard Schluter was recognized for 10 years of service on the team and

for being credited with saving a co-worker's life. Frank Harrington was given a certificate for his 25 years of services as an Emergency First Aid Team member.

"People are always coming up to me and saying, 'Keep up the good work,' and 'Remember me? You helped me last year. Thanks.' If they only knew what bad shape we're in, they'd help," Harrington said.

Volunteers like Harrington and Schluter have handled anything from heart attacks to falls and bee stings, Lewis said.

To promote the activities, the NU Marching Band will perform a pre-game salute, while the NU Yell Squad will carry Red Cross flags.

Gov. Bob Kerrey and football coach Tom Osborne have taped some messages that will be played just before the national anthem encouraging the fans' support.
