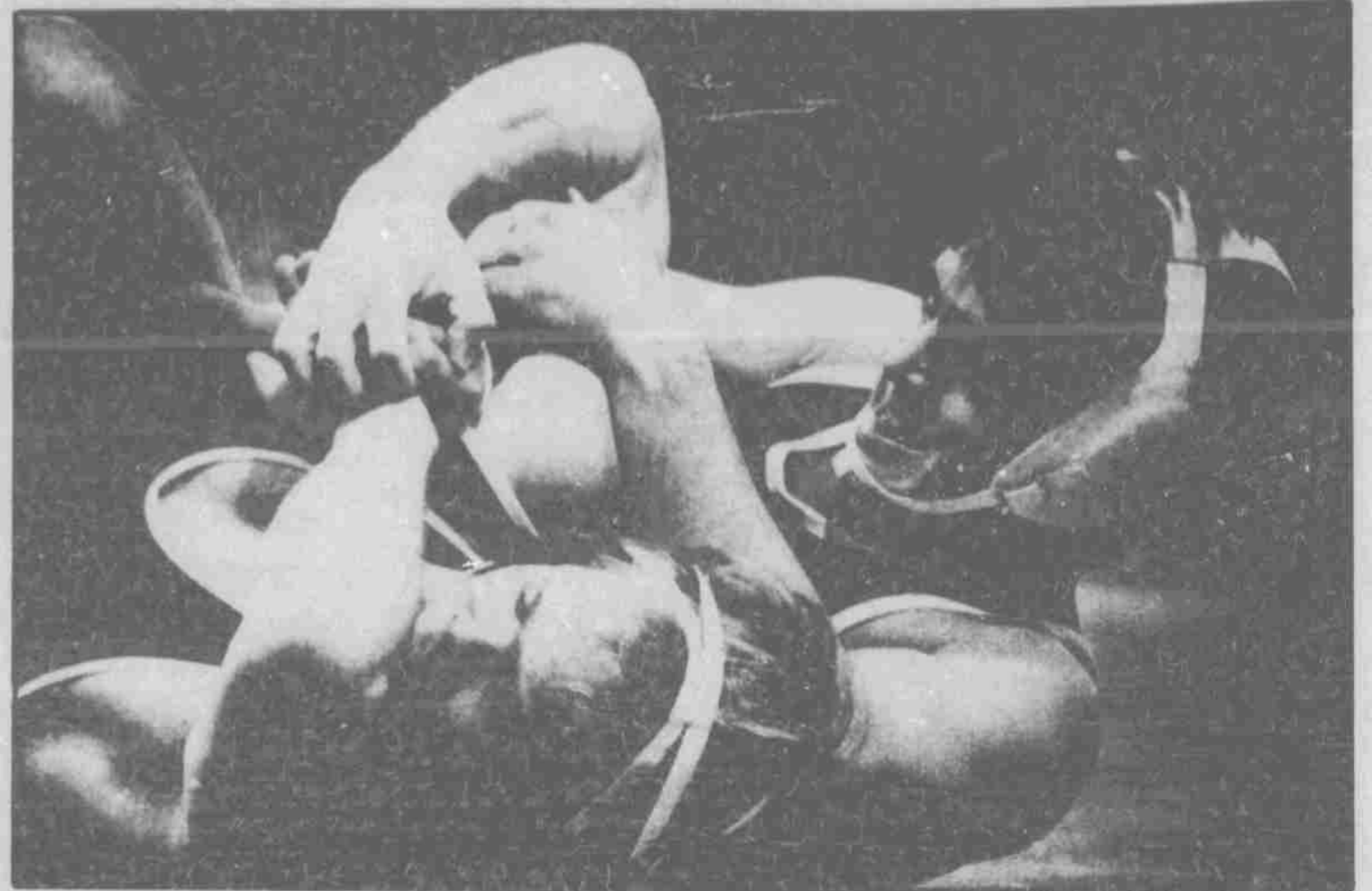

Campbell leads Husker wrestlers to undefeated weekend campaign

Although he was one of the smallest grapplers in the tournament, Nebraska's Matt Campbell stood above the rest of the competition at the Husker Duals this weekend at the Bob Devaney Sports Center.

Campbell, a 118-pound junior, and heavyweight Gary Albright paced the Huskers to a 4-0 mark in the eight-team meet by winning seven bouts. Nebraska posted wins over South Dakota State, Wisconsin River-Falls, Southern Illinois-Edwardsville and Augustana (South Dakota).

The following is a match-by-match rundown of the Husker's performance at the Duals.

SOUTH DAKOTA STATE — Nebraska rebounded from back-to-back dual losses to national powers Iowa State and Oklahoma with a 34-9 victory.

Campbell quickly gave the Huskers a 6-0 team lead by pinning Randy Weller with 30 seconds remaining in the first round. The pin was Campbell's second straight. His previous victim was Iowa State's Chuck Pearson.

"Matt has definitely been our bright spot this year," Nebraska coach Bob Fehrs said of the team's co-captain from Havre, Mont.

"He always had the ability, he just needed to put it together

consistently. If he keeps his intensity up, he'll be an all-American."

Campbell said that keeping his intensity level high was the key to his 14-0 start.

Other Huskers who joined Campbell in the winner's circle included: Al Lawrence (126), Bill Ferrie (142), Keenan Turner (150), Dan Boardman (167), Jake Sabo (177) and Albright, who pinned Al Holl-denn in 1:42.

WISCONSIN-RIVER FALLS — The Huskers raised their dual record to 3-2 as they thumped River Falls 42-3.

Mike Monfore (134), Albright and Sabo all posted first-round pins in their respective weight classes. Ferrie claimed a 15-0 decision against Chad Carpenter and Wallace Dawkins filled in for Campbell at 118 and won 10-6.

Freshman Jeff Coltvet recovered from an 8-6 loss to South Dakota State's Doug Cox with a default victory against Kenin Jung. The match was stopped with 1:30 remaining when Jung was unable to continue with a deep cut under his right eye.

Other Nebraska winners included freshmen Terry Cook (126), Tim Kenney (150) and Cody Olson (177).

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS-EDWARDSVILLE — Nebraska squeaked passed Edwardsville, the defend-

ing Division II national champions, 24-22.

The Cougars boast seven returning all-Americans and three returning individual national champions, including 118-pound sophomore Tim Wright.

The showdown between Wright and Campbell lived up to its pre-meet expectations.

Wright grabbed a 14-2 lead and appeared to be cruising to an easy win early in the third period.

Trailing 16-5 with 20 seconds left in the match, Campbell scored a takedown and a near-fall before pinning Wright with six seconds remaining.

Campbell said determination kept him in the match.

"It just goes to show that a match is never over until the final whistle blows," Campbell said.

Turner and Albright both pinned their opponents in the second round. Ferrie and Sabo won by decisions to complete the Husker's scoring.

AUGUSTANA — The Huskers capped off a successful weekend of wrestling by beating Augustana, 24-18.

Ferrie claimed his fourth win of the tournament, pinning Jack Schmidt in 4:29. Albright and Sabo also posted 4-0 records.


Turner won his fourth straight match by decisioning Jon Groskreutz, 6-3, and Campbell won by default.
