The mother lives in her little world of expectation. The children are possessed by the television. The movie is a fairly accurate sweep of some personal insights and societal problems. 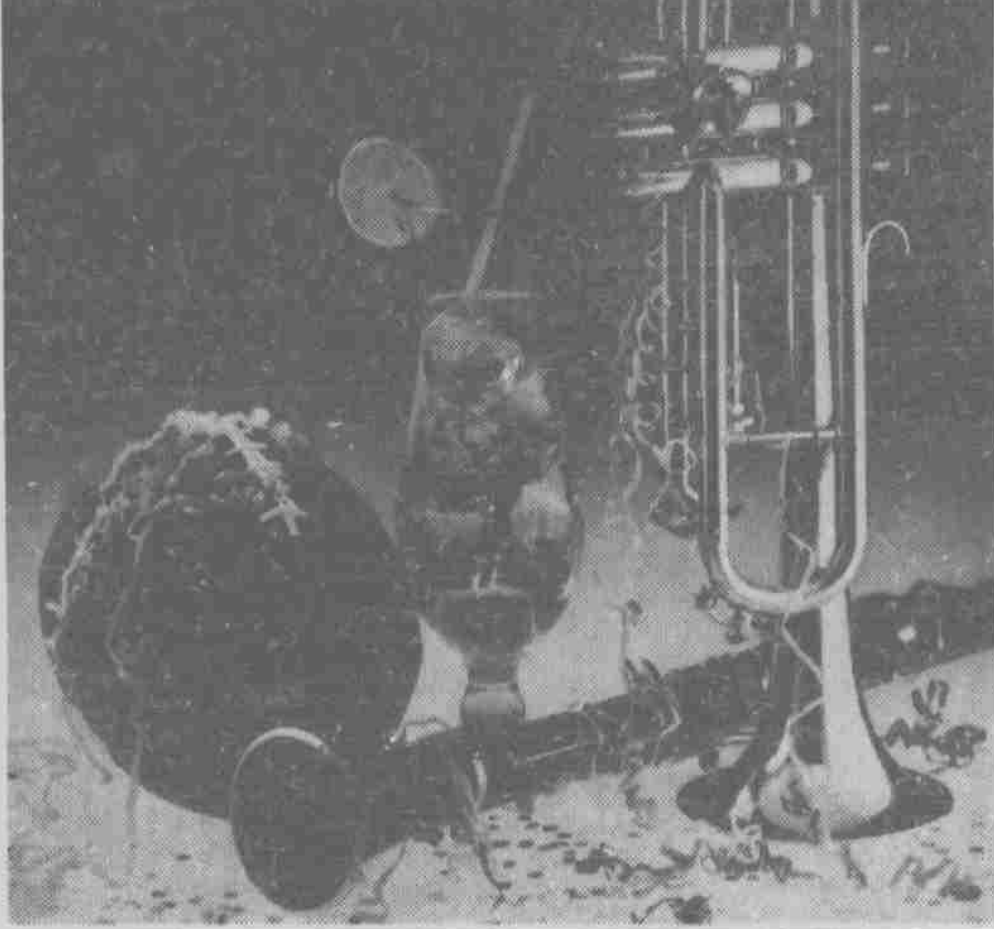
