Nelson uses a mix of calypso and reggae to bring his feelings to life. This mix is combined in a music form known as soca, which is regge speeded up to its maximuun level.

The style and attultude of the band is laid back, und this is reflected heavily on the album Many of the soniss lull in complacency, cousing an unexpected fealing of boredom.
On songs such as "Free Yourself" and the reggae instrumental "Tribute," Shangoya seems the use of so many instruments and thythee
