What's in a name?

A descriptive element used to designate an individual, place or thing, not all names are created equal.

In the world of sports, it's not the name a player brings to the competition that matters, it's the nickname. Monikers, pseudonyms, call them what you will, but nicknames color an athlete's performance, especially in college basketball, where they are used extensively.

When John Doe grabs a rebound the fans clap politely, but when Charles "the round mound of REBOOOOUND" tips a rebound down, the place goes crazy.

While at first it may seem that giving a player a good nickname is an easy process, one quickly becomes aware of the intricacies involved in the hanging of a moniker.



CREATIVITY First and foremost, a good nickname must be creative and original. A good nickname should be like a great painting — an individual entity with its own presence and statement.

Rule 1: A nickname loses it's effectiveness if it is used more than once. Dwayne Washington is a super sophomore guard for the Syracuse Orangemen. A flashy player, Washington goes by the nickname "Pearl." It's not a bad nickname if it weren't for the fact that Earl "the Pearl" Monroe used it for more than 10 years in the NBA.

Rule 2: Variations of a popular nickneme can be successful. Julius "Dr. J" Erving may have the most recognizable nickname in the sports world. For years every Tom, Dick and Julius who could dribble a ball was nicknamed Dr. this and Dr. that, slandering the good name of Erving. What these would be Drs. forgot is to be creative with their title. Along comes Detlef Schrempf a 6-9 forward for the Washington Huskies and a native of Leverkusen, West Germany. A high fiyer who can do just about anything with the ball, Schrempf included his abilities and his heritage in his nickname and came up with "Herr Dr. J."

DESCRIPTIVE Anickname should describe the relative merits of the player. Charles Barkley (you remember the "round mound of rebound"), long known for his voracious appetite, was aptly dubbed "Boy Gorge." Florida's 6-8 dunking power forward goes by the moniker of Eugene "the Jammin' Machine" McDowell while Georgia Tech's 7-0, 220-pound wirey forward John Salley is better known as "the Spider."

Some names are too obvious. St. John's freshman swingman Shelton Jones is a native of Amityville, N.Y. The creative minds went to work. He's now called "The Amityville Horror." How
