UNL health center offers five-day stop smoking clinic

A five-day stop smoking clinic which will focus on the problem of "craving for a cigarette" and what a smoker can do to cure the problem, will begin at the University Health Center on Sunday.

The clinic also is designed to make people aware of the damage smoking can do to the human body.

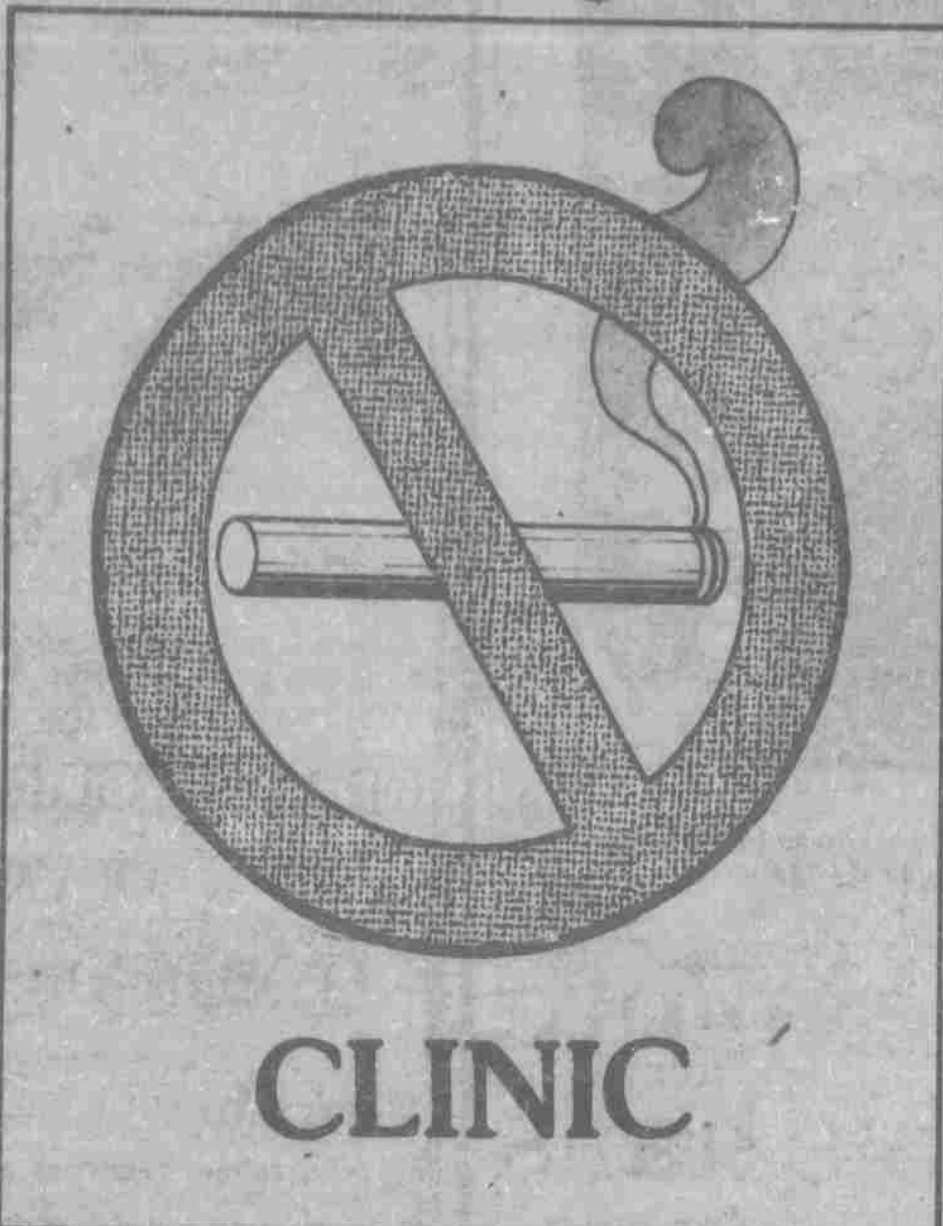
Joe "Andy" Anderson, a clinical technician at the health center, will conduct the clinic.

Anderson, who has taught smoking clinics for eight years, said that if people follow the program they can stop smoking. But, he said, the program can only be successful for those "who really want to stop smoking."

"We don't want the people who say they can quit but really can't," Anderson said.

The 5-day clinics begin Sunday and run until Feb. 21. The sessions are from 7 to 9 p.m. in Selleck Quadrangle's Multi-purpose Room.

Ambassador program to attract high school seniors to university

Student representatives will promote "Life at UNL" this March in an attempt to bring prospective college students here.

The chancellor's Ambassadors Program, a new project in the pre-admissions office, will inform prospective college students about UNL while they are deciding which college to attend.

Ann Franking, coordinator of the program, said she hopes that by reaching

more students earlier, the program will increase enrollment at UNL.

But Lisa Schmidt, director of pre-admissions, said the program "is not just to build numbers."

"It's to get good information about the university to outstanding students," Schmidt said.

Franking said work on the program began early this semester. It will be about two years before the ambassadors program is in full swing, she said. In the beginning of the program, ambassadors will help plan and operate campus tours such as the first "Rusker

Monday," scheduled for April 22.

As the program becomes established, the ambassadors will assume more responsibilities and may visit high schools to talk to college-bound students about UNL, Franking said.

The program committee is looking for freshmen, sophomore and junior UNL students from Nebraska with various academic backgrounds, Franking said.

Applications for the program are available until March 6 from the pre-admissions office, Administration Building 207.
