The Huskers defeated Southwest Missouri 7-2 and Oral Roberts 6-3, but lost to Wichits State (8-1) and Southwest Baptist (4.5). The Wichita State match was played in Wichitz, while the other three matches were in Springfield, Mo.

Smidt, a senior from Phoenix, was Nebraska's sole winner against the Shockers with a 3-6, 6-3, 6-2 victory over Paul Rosenich. Smidt won a three-set match over Southwest


