

ASUN, RHA commissions resolve discrepancy over election rules

The ASUN electoral commission decided Monday to warn the Look Party of illegal campaigning in the residence halls, instead of reprimanding them.

The commission withdrew the Residence Hall Association election commission's complaint calling for the reprimand of the Look Party for its door-to-door solicitation violation. The complaint asked the electoral commission to require the Look Party to remove all campaign posters from the residence halls, with the exception of one in each lobby.

The decision stems from an incident in which RHA election commission member Ken Libby saw two Look Party members, Jane Schenzel and Janet Markvicka, soliciting votes in Cather Hall. Schenzel is a candidate for the Committee for Fees Allocation and Markvicka is a candidate for the Home Economics Advisory Board.

The electoral commission overlooked the complaint against the Look Party because RHA election commission members agreed to its drafting without calling a formal meeting, so Look Party members could not respond, Libby said.

In other action, the ASUN electoral commission questioned the discrepancy between ASUN and RHA election rules. James McShane, associate professor of English and faculty adviser for the commission, said he was unaware of RHA's "Rip at WHI" policy for removing illegal campaign posters.

Gary Aurand, RHA election commissioner and Change Party candidate for the College of Engineering and Technology, said RHA gave itself the power to remove all illegal campaign posters that violated RHA election rules and Office of University Housing rules.

The commission initially removed the illegally placed posters. Later the commission contacted Marlene Beyke, ASUN director of development, about

further violations, Aurand said. To prevent more misunderstandings, the ASUN electoral commission and RHA election commission agreed to three items:

- RHA election commission rules will be incorporated into the ASUN electoral commission rules, as affirmed

by ASUN. ● The RHA election commission will not change its rules thereafter during an election.

- The RHA election commission will refer to the ASUN electoral commission for sanctions for infractions and enforcement of election rules.
