

# Sheldon show relives American art movements

## REVIEW ART

There is no need to trek across the country to places like New York or Chicago to see the work of America's great artists. Just walk over to the Sheldon Memorial Art Gallery. A new show,

"American Works on Paper," which opened last Friday, contains drawings and paintings on paper by almost every major American artist of the past century.

The show covers the great art movements of the past 100 years. The work ranges from realistic art of the turn of the century, to abstract expressionism, to the pop art of the Sixties, to contemporary work. Whatever your taste in art, you should find something to tickle your fancy at this show.

What made the show interesting was that the drawings and watercolors of many of these artists are seldom seen. Most art galleries and books show only the artists' oil paintings or prints, giving their other works second-class status. However, the works in this show are anything but second class.

Winslow Homer, Georgia O'Keeffe, Jackson Pollock, Roy Lichtenstein. If these names sound familiar, it is because they helped shape American art. They and many other famous artists,

such as Andrew Wyeth and Alexander Calder, to drop a few names, have works on paper in the show, done in a broad range of media.

Individually, the works are impressive. One piece which, though not precisely American, is a study by Marcel Duchamp for his controversial painting, "Nude Descending a Staircase," which turned the American art scene on its head. Beyond its historical significance, it is a beautiful piece of art to look at.

Just as impressive is a watercolor by Winslow Homer. It shows Homer at his best, capturing the elemental forces of nature and man with a view that makes the commonplace monumental. An artist whose work is usually monumental in size, Jackson Pollock, has a small but well done work in enamel on paper.

"American Works on Paper" runs through Sunday, April 21. This show is a must for anyone who is at all interested in American art of the past century.
