Students give troubled youths attention, care they lack, need

UNL criminal science, psychology and sociology students can gain valuable job experience by volunteering at the Lincoln Youth Attention Center.

Kristi Krueger, a UNL education major and volunteer coordinator at the center, said the center is looking for students to work with youths.

"We need the volunteers to play games with the kids, talk to them and just make the kids feel like somebody cares about them," Krueger said.

Jon Hill, center director, said interaction shows young people that they can do things without cheating or using foul language.

The center, which opened in January 1976 at 220 S. 10th St., has two functions: to detain youths under 18 who have been arrested by the police and to rehabilitate those who have been sentenced to a maximum of one year at the center. The average age of young people in

Hill said the program appears to be successful, but it is still too early to determine how successful it is.

Most of the young people have many problems and need somebody to pay attention to them, he said. Sometimes it's the first time they've received any attention, he said.

Krueger said volunteers tutor, teach arts and crafts and join in recreational




