should check in at 8:30 p.m. to get a time slot. Open stage runs from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. and there is no cover charge.

From the corner of the room on the stage came the strains of classical French acoustic guitar. Open stage co-host Chris Sayre really knew how to set the mood on a cold, rainy night.

Sayre introduced the first of the 20-minute acts. Scott Stewart did some strumming of his own with songs like "Faithless Love" and Bruce Springsteen's "I'm on Fire."

The music switched from guitar to casio with the second act performed by Bill Sundeen. He played some Hank Williams and Graham Nash songs. He finished with "Let it Be."

The next act was a group called Aspen, comprised of two guitar players, one of whom doubled on flute. They played a lot of music from the '60s — mainly Crosby, Stills and Nash.

The evening was one of sharing —
