

# Playing volleyball an 'honor'

## Freshman recruit brings consistency

Selected to Volleyball Monthly magazine's "Fabulous Fifty," as one of the top fifty players entering the collegiate volleyball scene, the highly recruited UNL freshman Lori Endicott says playing for the Nebraska volleyball team is an honor.

"As a freshman, I feel playing for such a high caliber team is a reward, and it will help me develop into a better player for the future," Endicott said.

For now, coach Terry Pettit said he thinks Endicott's contribution to the team has been consistency.

"Lori's been consistently the first or second player off the bench. Her play has been real consistent, especially against stronger teams, but she's pretty much played the same level regardless of the opponent," Pettit said. "We really don't lose much from the starting level when she's in."

Endicott realizes that getting playing time on such a good team won't be easy.

"If I work hard in practice it will pay off and I'll get to play. So I push myself harder so that I can play in more games," she said.

This past summer Endicott gained experience by playing on the Mid-American Junior Olympic Team which toured Canada.

"That really prepared me to play with better athletes, and better teams," Endicott said.

Pettit has already seen some improvements in Endicott's game since she came to Nebraska.

"Lori is physically very strong. She has strong and consistent serves, and since coming here, her attacking has improved," Pettit said. "She's also putting extra time into her serve, setting practice with Tisha Delaney, and it's also getting more consistent."

So far this season Endicott's main job has been to play defense.

"Right now I come in and help out defensively," Endicott said. "Hopefully, in the future I can come in and play front row as well."

Pettit said Endicott has started some games opposite Tisha Delaney in a 6-2 offense, and has done well. The Huskers main offense this season has been a 5-1, with Delaney as the only setter.

Pettit said he isn't quite sure what Endicott's exact role for the future is, but right now she is definitely in the Nebraska game plan.

"Maybe two years down the road she'll be our setter in a 5-1 offense, depending on the recruits we get. But right now she definitely figures in our game plan, and she's doing a fine job when we put her in," he said.

Endicott said her only thoughts now are making it to the final four.

"We have a great team, with great athletes, and we have a really good chance at making it to the final four teams in the country," Endicott said.
