# 'Olympic Challenge' records heroes, making of the 1984 Summer Games



"Olympic Challenge," a one-hour documentary airing 10 p.m. Sunday on Nebraska Educational TV, celebrates the backstage heroes who made the 1984 Olympics a success.

The program follows the key individuals in security, sports, medical, transportation and other departments at the Los Angeles Olympic Organizing Committee as they prepare for the Games.

The result is a unique look at the making of the Summer Games, showing a side not seen during coverage of the athletic competition.

The daily frustrations and triumphs of Opening Ceremonies director Tommy Walker are followed closely in "Olympic Challenge." Dramatic scenes around a bomb scare at the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, security negotiations over the Libyan flag bearers and arrival of the presidential motorcade also are covered.

Viewers are taken inside the communications center where reports from dozens of security agencies, from the Secret Service and the FBI to local police and fire departments, were processed simultaneously to coordinate emergency services in the event of a major disaster or terrorist attack.
