## Alumni dedicate Wick Center

Garden are examples of NU's alumni excellence, said Jack Miller, executive vice president of the UNL Alumni Association.

Speaking at the center's dedication ceremony Friday, Miller said the Alumni Association will become especially important for upholding the university's excellence as it faces further budget cuts.

During the ceremony, Robert Rosenlof, chairman of the Wick Center Building Committee, gave a gold "key" to NU Board of Regents' chairman John Payne, UNL Chancellor Martin Massengale and ASUN President Gerard Keating. Payne accepted the key, saying it represented the dedication between the alumni and the university that will be enhanced by the Wick Center.

Plans for the center began in 1978 when Milton I. Wick, class of 1922, gave \$500,000 to NU to be matched by other

NU alumni.

Gwathmey Siegel and Associates, a New York City firm, submitted the award winning building design in May 1981. Construction began a year later.

In 1983, George C. and Irene Mangold Holling of Omaha committed money for construction of a garden to the east of the center on 16th and R streets.

The center was finished in April 1985, and the garden was finished this month. The total cost of the building, furnishings and garden was \$3.6 million.

In a closing statement, Rosenlof said the joy of having a new building for the 111-year-old Alumni Association is tempered by the grave economic situation facing NU. But he said the association has helped the university meet challenges in the past and will continue to do so in the future.

### Setting it Straight

An article in Friday's Daily Nebraskan titled "ASUN votes to support Lied Center" said ASUN senators rejected a resolution supporting an NSSA proposal that urged the Legislature to set a

course for long-term recovery of the state's budget problems. The senate did not defeat the resolution but merely tabled it until a further meeting.

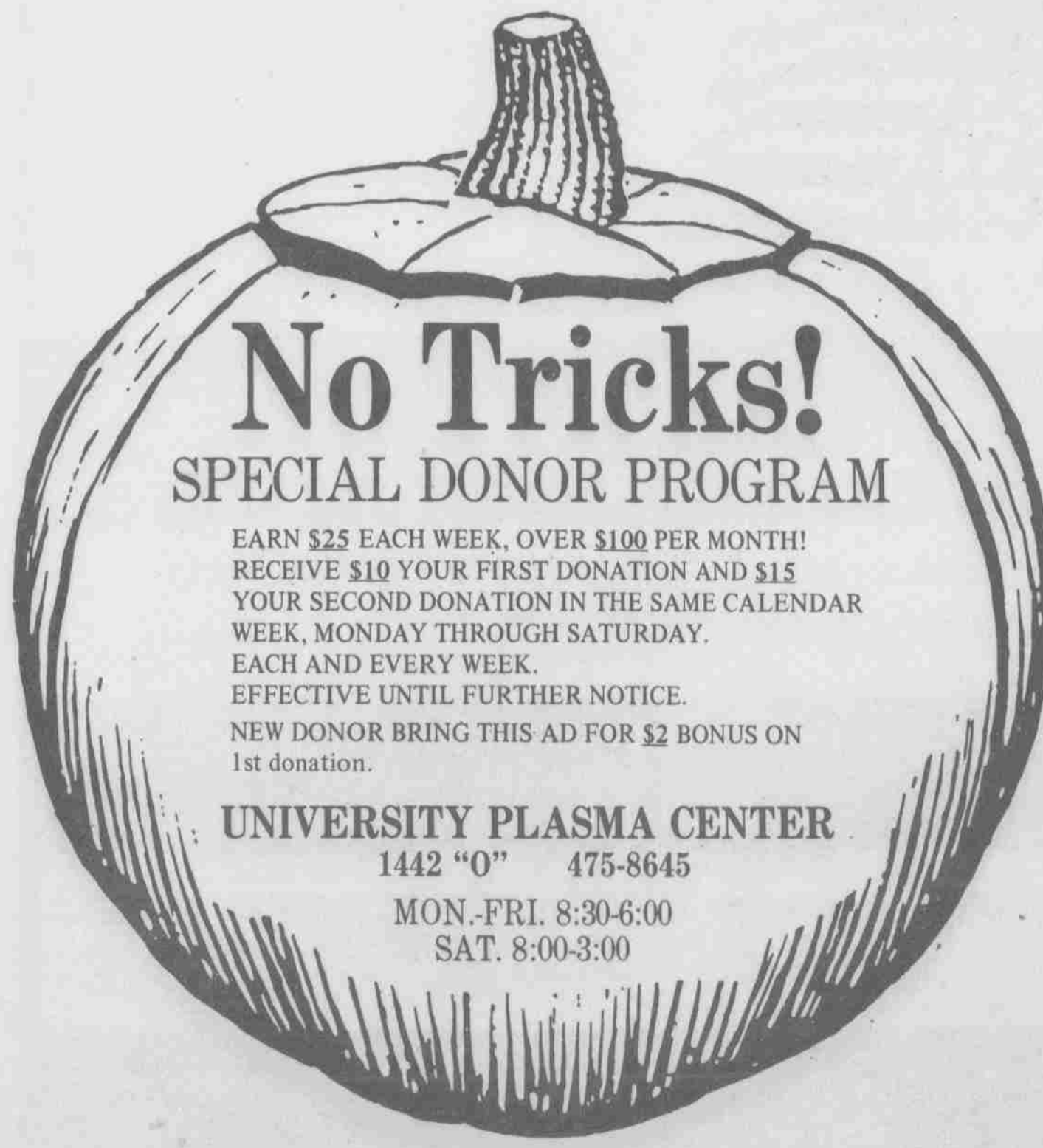
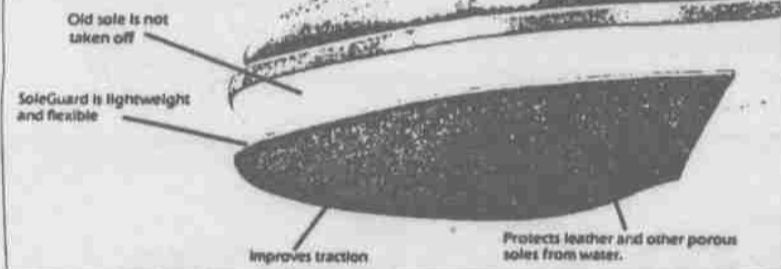
