Neil Simon comedy to play at experimental theater

The Nebraska Director's Theatre, known for its presentation of lesser-known experimental plays, will venture toward the mainstream with its production of "I Ought To Be In Pictures."

The Neil Simon comedy is most widely known in its movie form, a 1982 film starring Walter Matthau, Dinah Manoff and Ann Margaret.

"I Ought To Be In Pictures" opens as 19-yearold Libby Tucker arrives in a Hollywood suburb with glamorous dreams. She has just hitchhiked from Brooklyn to meet her father, well-known screenwriter Herb Tucker, and launch her career in show business.
