At the same time the Wolverines have three outstanding receivers in Paul Jokisch, John Colesar and tight end Eric Kattus, Hanlon said.

Jokisch, a 6-8 junior, spent his first two years at Michigan playing basketball, before he switched to football.

"Jokisch is a trememdous receiver. He uses his height like Harold Carmicheal (a former Philadelphia Eagle and Dallas Cowboy) used to in the NFL." Hanlon said. "Our other two receivers - Colesar and Kattus - are also both good athletes, although we don't ask Kattus to run very much."

Michigan defensive coordinator Gary Moeller said this year's defense also contributed to the Wolverines' success. It is among the nation's finest, he said.

Statistically, the Michigan defense led the nation in fewest points allowed per game (averaging 6.8). It is second to Oklahoma in total defense and ranks sixth in rushing defense.

"A large part of our success defensively this season can be traced to the fact that we have gotten such great leadership this season," Moeller said. "We're going to need it, though, because Nebraska is going to be one tough team to prepare for."

Moeller said that he considers linebackers Andy Moeller and Mike Mallory and defensive tackle Mike Hammerstein to be the defensive leaders.


